### Issue 2: Should this docket be closed?

**Recommendation:** If no person whose substantial interests are affected by the proposed agency action files a protest within 21 days of the issuance of the order, a consummating order should be issued. If the utility's petition for a rule waiver is granted, then the docket should remain open pending the Commission's decision regarding NFCWS's petition for a limited proceeding. However, if the utility's petition for a rule waiver is denied, then the docket should be closed upon the issuance of the consummating order.
