I am contacting you to object to the latest request by Sunshine Water Services for *yet another* rate increase. I recently received a letter informing me of such a request scheduled for a hearing Tuesday, February 11, 2025.

It seems that Sunshine Water Services applies for and receives a rate increase at nearly every legal opportunity.

Services provided by Sunshine Water Services are essentially sewer service and were originally tied directly to water usage. However, due to the repeated rate increases that is no longer true.

At the present, my bills from Sunshine Water Services are nearly double that of my water bill. And the rates keep going up.
