1 P R O C E E D I N G S

2 CHAIRMAN LA ROSA: Let's go and move to Item
3 No. 10, and, Mr. Davis, you are back up.
4 Excellent.

5 MR. DAVIS: Yes, sir.

6 CHAIRMAN LA ROSA: Efficient this morning. So
7 go ahead and give us a summary when you are ready.

8 MR. DAVIS: Okay. Like Items 6 through 8,
9 Item 10 is FPUC's petition for approval of its 2025
10 DSM plan, which staff recommends be approved.

11 In addition to the DSM plan, FPUC is
12 requesting approval of an LED lighting program.
13 The proposed program would replace approximately
14 7,100 existing non-LED outside lights with more
15 efficient LED lights over a two-year period.

16 FPUC has not requested that the demand in
17 energy savings be counted toward their approved DSM
18 goal achievements, which is consistent with the
19 Commission's decision regarding a similar program
20 for TECO in 2018.

21 Like the prior TECO program, FPUC seeks to
22 create a regulatory asset for unrecovered costs of
23 the non-LED lighting, incremental costs for the new
24 LEDs, and some program expenses, as well as to
25 recover a credit per non-LED light replaced.

1 Staff is recommending approval of the LED
2 lighting program and creation of a regulatory asset
3 with some modification. Staff agrees the
4 unrecovered costs of the old non-LED lights should
5 be included in a regulatory asset, but recommends
6 removing communication expenses and the net base
7 rate adjustment for the new LED lighting.

8 Staff is also requesting administrative
9 authority to approve the revised program standards
10 and credit amount based on these modifications.

11 CHAIRMAN LA ROSA: Commissioners, any
12 questions or thoughts on Item No. 10? Item No. 10.
13 Seeing none, is there a motion?

14 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Move to approve the item,
15 Mr. Chairman.

16 COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: Second.

17 CHAIRMAN LA ROSA: Hearing a motion and
18 hearing a second.

19 All those in favor signify by saying yay.

21 CHAIRMAN LA ROSA: Yay.

22 Opposed no?

23 (No response.)

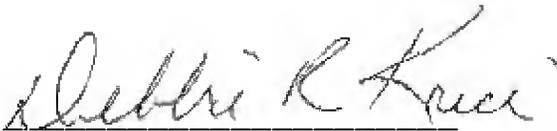
