As an owner on Little Gasparilla Island, I wanted to thank you for your decision to reject the application of wastewater treatment by Environmental Utilities, LLC. The type of system they were proposing, which was not a viable system due to need of electrical backup, the prohibitive costs as well as the disruption to the environmental sensibilities of the island, caused me great concern and anxiety as I was not in favor of any type of central sewer system. My current septic field has never been an issue, I maintain it, it is code as to county regulations, and most importantly, it was functional after each major hurricane, which would not have been the case with a central wastewater system, especially the one that was proposed. Additionally, the costs that were involved, as well as future usage costs, were astronomical and unaffordable.

I appreciate again that you listened to our concerns and rejected this proposal.
