1	PROCEEDINGS
2	CHAIRMAN LA ROSA: Let's move to Item No. 7,
3	and Ms. McClelland, you are recognized.
4	MS. McCLELLAND: Good morning, Commissioners.
5	This is Kate McClelland with Commission staff.
6	Item No. 7 is a petition by Peoples Gas, or
7	PGS, for approval to revise tariffs associated with
8	its swing service rider, individual transportation
9	service, or ITC rate class, and off-system service,
10	or OSS, sharing mechanism.
11	PGS is seeking to modify the calculation of
12	supply costs, storage costs and weighted cost of
13	capacity to more accurately reflect actual costs
14	included in the swing service rider. The proposed
15	modifications to the ITS rider would raise the
16	threshold to 500,000 therms of consumption per year
17	and transfer the customers below the threshold to
18	the natural choice transportation service rider.
19	ITS customers would also be required to take 25
20	percent of their daily capacity release requirement
21	from PGS.
22	Finally, the company has proposed to modify
23	its OSS sharing mechanism. Currently, 75 percent
24	of OSS net revenue is booked to the PGA, while 25
25	percent of revenue is retained by the utility above

1	the line. The utility is seeking to split the OSS
2	net revenue evenly between the PGA and retained
3	revenue.
4	Staff has reviewed the proposed modifications
5	and believes that they are designed to improve the
6	allocation of costs between transportation and PGA
7	customers when taken as a whole. Staff recommends
8	that the Commission should approve the proposed
9	tariff modifications.
