I live in Miami because I was born and reared here, and I don't like the cold. I also have solar panels on my house, impact-resistant windows, and an electric car.

I have always had a relatively low electric bill. After I got the solar panels in 2019, the bill drifted down to \$10.05 a month. That was the minimum monthly bill that the Florida government allows FPL to charge, so it won't have to modernize and become more efficient, and so it can keep soaking up Floridians' money. (Clearly, FPL donates campaign money to Florida electeds, and it is FPL, not the public and the voters, which is the constituent about which electeds care.)

In 2022, my minimum monthly bill suddenly tripled to \$30.17 a month. Yeah, same dynamic. As a frame of reference, my daughter and son-in-law live in Massachusetts, have fewer solar panels than I do, despite that their house is larger, and often enough get no bill from the electric company (Eversource). Sometimes, they also get a small check for the fact that they make more electricity than they use, and Eversource can sell it to someone else.

Now, the Florida PSC, most certainly at the urging of the Florida legislature and governor, is aiming to raise my minimum monthly bill again.
