On October 3, 2025, Florida Power & Light (FPL) filed a request for confidential classification pursuant to Section 366.093(3)(e) of the Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C), for information contained in Exhibit SRB-13 attached to the Settlement Rebuttal Testimony of FPL witness Scott R. Bores (Document No. 1493-2025) filed in the above referenced docket.

FPL claims the confidential information includes proprietary confidential business information regarding competitive business interests of FPL, the disclosure of which would harm the competitive business of FPL. Specifically, the document contains competitive business information regarding FPL financial forecasts. The release of this information could impair our competitive interests to the detriment of FPL and its customers, and it would violate Securities and Exchange Commission rules regarding the disclosure of material non-public information. This information is protected by Section 366.093(3)(e), Florida Statutes. The information is intended to be and has been treated by FPL as private, its confidentiality has been maintained, and its disclosure would cause harm to FPL and its customers.

Staff reviewed the documents and information included in the discovery response and concurs with FPL. In staff's opinion, the Company's request meets the criteria for confidentiality set forth in Section 366.093(3)(e), F.S. Therefore, staff recommends that FPL's request for confidential classification of the information contained in Document No. 14203-2025 be approved.
