RE: Docket 20200234-EI - Petition for approval of direct current microgrid pilot program and for variance from or waiver of Rule 25-6.065, F.A.C., by Tampa Electric Company.

Pursuant to Order No. PSC-2021-0237-PAA-EI (Order), issued June 30, 2021, Tampa Electric Company (TECO or Company) was required to provide annual reports as well as a final report to the Commission that assessed, both quantitatively and qualitatively, the overall direct current microgrid pilot program and determined the merits of a permanent program. The Order also required that the Company survey pilot participants on their willingness to pay a monthly surcharge for increased reliability, with the survey results to be included in the final report.

On October 31, 2025, TECO filed a final report after determining that it was not feasible to continue the pilot program, switched the pilot participants to TECO's traditional distribution system, and dismantled the pilot program equipment. Upon review of TECO's initial final report, staff determined that it did not meet the requirements of the Order. In response to staff's data request, the Company filed a revised final report on December 17, 2025. Staff's review determined that the revised final report meets the requirements of the Order; therefore, staff is requesting that this docket be closed administratively and all confidential filings be returned to the source.
