I am 86, living on a fixed income from Social Security; therefore I feel the proposed increase is unjustified considering COL this year was only 2.8% and Sun Communities has just raised our rent more than what the COL was. I am not opposed to a REASONABLE rate increase but what they are proposing is totally UNACCEPTABLE.

As stated by Sun Communities there are 17 general customers that use Water Oak's water that apparently are not being billed and have not disclosed who these customers are so are we (the homeowners) are being billed for their usage?
