**DUKE ENERGY FLORIDA, LLC'S
THIRD REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION**

Duke Energy Florida, LLC, ("DEF" or "Company"), pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), submits this Third Request for Extension of Confidential Classification (the "Request") for certain information contained in the transcript for the deposition of Terry Hobbs taken on June 25, 2020, and late-filed Exhibit number 3 to said deposition, served on July 21, 2020. In support of this Request, DEF states:

1. On July 21, 2020, DEF filed its Fourteenth Request for Confidential Classification (document number 03928-2020), for certain information contained in the transcript for the deposition of Terry Hobbs taken on June 25, 2020, and late-filed Exhibit number 3 to said deposition, as it contains "confidential proprietary business information" under Section 366.093(3), Florida Statutes.

2. DEF's July 21, 2020 Request was granted by Order No. PSC-2020-0361-CFO-EI on October 12, 2020. On March 29, 2022, DEF filed its First Request for Extension of Confidential

Classification which was granted by Order No. PSC-2022-0236-CFO-EI on June 27, 2022. On December 21, 2023, DEF filed its Second Request for Extension of Confidential Classification. This Request was granted by Order No. PSC-2024-0391-CFO-EI on September 3, 2024. The period of confidential treatment granted by that order will expire on March 3, 2026. The information continues to warrant treatment as “proprietary confidential business information” within the meaning of Section 366.093(3), F.S. Accordingly, DEF is filing its Third Request for Extension of Confidential Classification.

3. DEF submits that the information contained in the transcript for the deposition of Terry Hobbs taken on June 25, 2020, and late-filed Exhibit number 3 to said deposition, identified in Exhibit “A” and Exhibit “C” to the July 21, 2020, Request¹ continues to be “proprietary confidential business information” within the meaning of section 366.093(3), F.S. and continue to require confidential classification. This information is intended to be and is treated as confidential by the Company. The information has not been disclosed to the public. Pursuant to section 366.093(1), F.S., such materials are entitled to confidential treatment and are exempt from the disclosure provisions of the Public Records Act.

4. Nothing has changed since the issuance of Order No. PSC-2020-00361-CFO-EI to render the information stale or public such that continued confidential treatment would not be appropriate. Upon a finding by the Commission that this information continues to be “proprietary confidential business information,” it should continue to be treated as such for an additional period of at least 18 months and should be returned to DEF as soon as the information is no longer necessary for the Commission to conduct its business. *See* §366.093(4), F.S.
