**Re: Docket No. 20260000-OT - JEA's Fuel Emergency Plan**

Dear Mr. Baker:

Pursuant to Rule 25-6.0185, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), electric utilities that own or control generation facilities are required to file a long-term energy emergency plan with the Commission and the Florida Reliability Coordinating Council. Such plans establish a systematic means to assess and respond to a prolonged fuel supply shortage. In addition, each utility must provide a periodic notification to the Commission that it has reviewed its energy emergency plan. Such written notification is required every three years, beginning with January 31, 1999, and should include either a revised plan for approval or a statement that the current plan on file with the Commission is adequate.

On February 23, 2026, JEA filed a notification stating that its Fuel Emergency Plan, Document No. 00787-2009, dated January 30, 2009, is still adequate and complies with the requirements of Rule 25-6.0185, F.A.C. Thank you for this notification and JEA should file its next notification of review by January 31, 2029. In order to streamline the review process, I would ask that any subsequent plan revisions be provided in both type-and-strike and clean formats.
