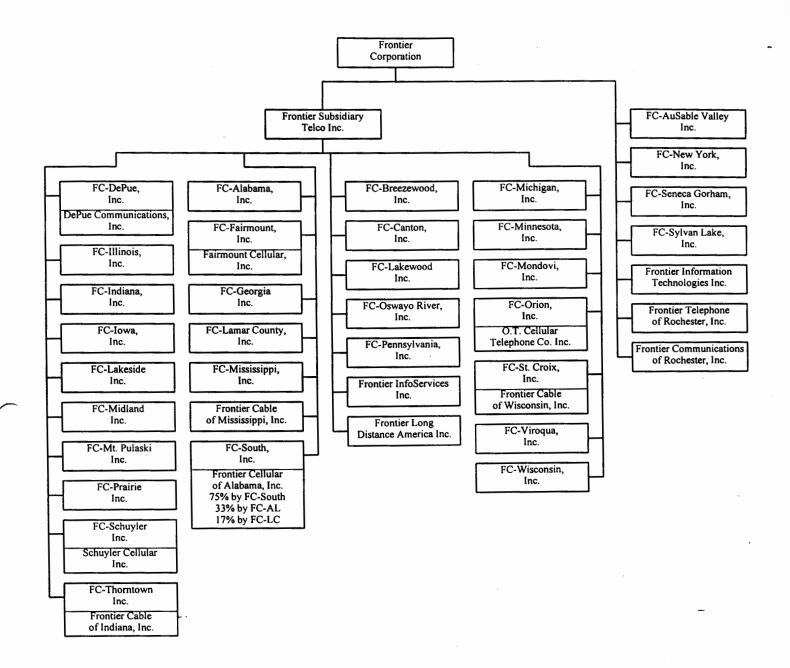

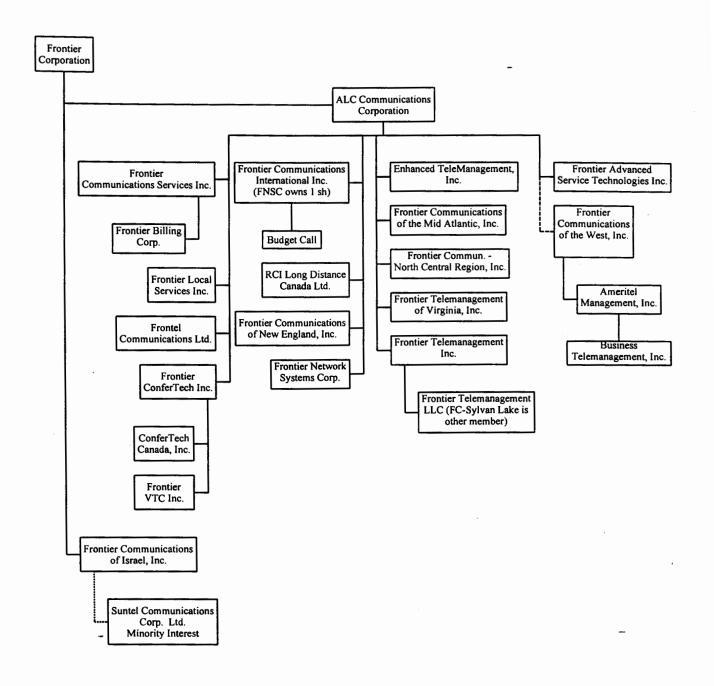

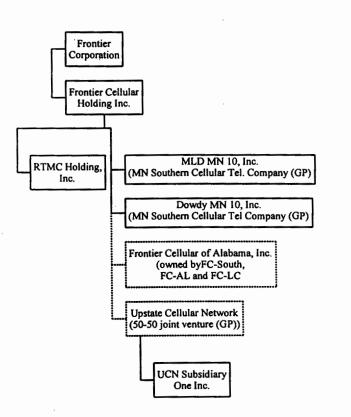
Telephone Operations and Other Entities as of December 31, 1997 (AASTelco.OPX)
