These financial statements (including related disclosures) and the supplementary information are presented in accordance with the requirements of the Florida Public Service Commission, which differ from generally accepted accounting principles. Accordingly, these financial statements and supplementary information are not designed for those who are not informed about such differences.

We are not independent with respect to Windstream Utilities Company.

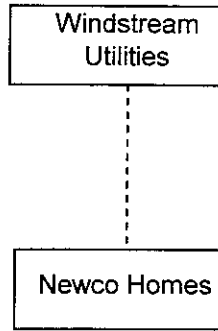
