The purpose of this filing is to indicate that charges for Directory Assistance Service for requests of a local or national number will not be applicable to calls placed from customers whose physical, visual, or reading handicaps prevent them from using the telephone directory. Previously, these customers were only exempt from charges resulting from the request for LOCAL numbers. With this change, they are now exempt from charges resulting from the request for NATIONAL numbers as well.

The proposed effective date is September 26, 2006.

#### G. DIRECTORY ASSISTANCE SERVICE

##### 1. General

Directory Assistance Service gives customers access to telephone numbers of individuals or businesses by dialing 555-1212, 4-1-1 or 1-4-1-1.

##### 2. Definitions

- a. Local numbers are any NPA/NXXs within the customer's local calling area or home NPA.
- b. National numbers are any NPA/NXXs within the United States, Canada, Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands, but outside the customer's local calling area or home NPA.
- c. International numbers are numbers from outside the United States, Canada, Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands.

##### 3. Regulations

- a. A maximum of two requested telephone numbers are allowed per call.
- b. Rates will apply based on the NPA/NXX requested.
- c. Call allowances apply to requests for local numbers only.
- d. Charges for Directory Assistance Service for requests of a local or national numbers are not applicable to calls placed from customers whose physical, visual, or reading handicaps prevent them from using the telephone directory. Calls requesting international numbers will be charged the applicable rate. (C)
- e. Charges for Directory Assistance Service are not applicable to calls received from Public Pay Telephones. (C)

- c. Call allowances apply to requests for local numbers only.
- d. Charges for Directory Assistance Service for requests of a local number are not applicable to calls placed from customers whose physical, visual, or reading handicaps prevent them from using the telephone directory. Calls requesting ~~national and~~ international numbers will be charged the applicable rate. *and national* (c)
- e. Charges for Directory Assistance Service are not applicable to calls received from Public Pay Telephones. (c)
