

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Introduction

The purpose of this filing is to provide clarifying language for inclusion of appropriate rearrangement charges (as specified in Section A42.3) when converting from PRI to Centrex PRI. Currently, a PRI customer may convert from one form of PRI to another without incurring termination liability (assuming at least 24 months remains on the existing contract), but said changes will incur certain rearrangement charges (as specified in GSST section A42.3). In this filing the Centrex section of the GSST (A12) is being updated to reflect this policy.

Description of Proposed Tariff

The proposed tariff revision will include the following modifications:
Item 7 has been added under A12.25.8.A describing applicable service rearrangement charges (as described in A42.3 of the GSST) for 5ESS and DMS-100 switch types as follows:

Customers may elect to convert existing PRI to Centrex PRI, and vice versa. This is considered an inside move and service rearrangement charges apply (as indicated in A42.3.4.G of this Tariff). Applicable charges for 5ESS switch type include Type 1 (as indicated in A42.3.4.G.1.a of this Tariff) and Premise Visit (as indicated in A42.3.4.G.3.a of this Tariff) per access line converted. Applicable charges for DMS-100 switch type include Type 1 (as indicated in A42.3.4.G.1.a of this Tariff), Type 2 (as indicated in A42.3.4.G.1.b of this Tariff) and Premise Visit (as indicated in A42.3.4.G.3 of this Tariff) per access line converted.
