BE IT REMEMBERED that BRUCE H. COLTON, State Attorney for the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit of the State of Florida, prosecuting for the State of Florida, in Martin County, under oath, information makes that in Martin County on or about:

(A) CL. 1. ATTEMPTED FELONY MURDER

August 04, 2003 Brenton J. Johnson did perpetrate or attempt to perpetrate any felony enumerated in s. 782.04(3), to wit: Robbery and did commit, aid, or abet an intentional act that is not an essential element of said felony and that could have, but did not, cause the death of another, to wit: Pamela Anderson, and in the course of committing the robbery used, carried or discharged a firearm, and as a result of the discharge great bodily harm was inflicted upon Pamela Anderson, in violation of Florida Statutes §§ 782.051; 775.087 and 777.011.

(A) CL. 2. ATTEMPTED ROBBERY WITH A DEADLY WEAPON


