Florida Power & Light Company (“FPL”), pursuant to Order No. PSC-2023-0086-PCO-EG, hereby submits its Prehearing Statement regarding the issues to be addressed at the hearing scheduled for November 1-3, 2023.

3) STATEMENT OF BASIC POSITION

FPL's 2024 Conservation Cost Recovery Factors for the January 2024 through December 2024 recovery period, which include the 2022 net final true-up for FPL and the 2023 actual/estimated true-up for FPL, are appropriate and reasonable and should be approved.

4) STATEMENT OF ISSUES AND POSITIONS

ISSUE 1: **What is the final conservation cost recovery adjustment true-up amount for the period January 2022 through December 2022?**

FPL: FPL's final conservation cost recovery adjustment true-up amount for the period of January 2022 through December 2022, is \$6,951,067. (FPL witness Hume)

ISSUE 2: **What is the appropriate conservation adjustment actual/estimated true-up amount for the period January 2023 through December 2023?**

FPL: FPL's conservation adjustment actual/estimated true-up amount for the period of January 2023 through December 2023, including interest, is an over-recovery of \$12,332,373. (FPL witness Hume)

ISSUE 3: **What is the appropriate total conservation adjustment true-up amount to be collected/refunded from January 2024 through December 2024?**

FPL: FPL's total conservation adjustment true-up amount to be refunded from January 2024 through December 2024, is \$19,283,440. (FPL witness Hume)

ISSUE 4: **What is the total conservation cost recovery amount to be collected during the period January 2024 through December 2024?**

FPL: The total costs associated with the ECCR programs to be collected between January 1, 2024 and December 31, 2024, is \$143,718,548 (including prior true-up amounts). (FPL witness Floyd)

ISSUE 5: **What are the conservation cost recovery factors for the period January 2024 through December 2024?**

FPL: The appropriate FPL factors for the period January 2024 through December 2024 are:

ISSUE 6: What should be the effective date of the new conservation cost recovery factors for billing purposes?

FPL: The factors shall be effective for meter readings that occur on or after January 1, 2024. These charges shall continue in effect until modified by subsequent order of this Commission. (FPL witness Hume)

ISSUE 7: Should the Commission approve revised tariffs reflecting the energy conservation cost recovery amounts and energy conservation cost recovery factors determined to be appropriate in this proceeding?

FPL: Yes. The Commission should approve revised tariffs reflecting the energy conservation cost recovery factors determined to be appropriate in this proceeding. The Commission should direct Staff to verify that the revised tariffs are consistent with the Commission’s decision. (FPL witness Hume)

ISSUE 8: Should this docket be closed?

FPL: This docket is an on-going docket and should remain open. (FPL witness Hume)

5) STIPULATED ISSUES

FPL: Yet to be determined. FPL is willing to stipulate that the testimony of all witnesses whom no one wishes to cross-examine be inserted into the record as though read, cross-examination be waived, and the witnesses' attendance at the hearing be excused.
