

REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT

This AGREEMENT made this 1st day of May, 2021, by and between AT&T Corp., on behalf of itself and its affiliated companies, which has a place of business at 3450 Riverwood Parkway SE, Atlanta, GA 30339 (“AT&T”) and Florida Power & Light Company, having an address at 700 Universe Blvd., Juno Beach, FL 33408-0420 (“FPL”).

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, AT&T is a grantee of several easements that run parallel to the west side of I-75, in Columbia County, FL, to construct, operate, maintain, repair, and replace a buried communications facility encumbering several parcels of land (the “Easement Area”); and

WHEREAS, the Easement Area and any AT&T buried cable and associated facilities that have been placed within the Easement Area may be adversely impacted by FPL’s proposed construction within said easement strip; and

WHEREAS, FPL will reimburse AT&T for AT&T’s cost of protecting, and/or lowering a section of the AT&T facilities, a section of the AT&T Valdosta, GA to Ellisville, FL LG Cable that runs from AT&T Station Number 372+121 to AT&T Station Number 380+728, in Columbia County, FL (the “Cable”);

NOW THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

1. AT&T will provide engineering, plant protection, labor, materials, and supervision necessary to protect, relocate and/or lower the Cable, as deemed necessary in AT&T’s sole judgment (the “Work”). The Work is more particularly described in attached **Exhibit A**. The starting date will be mutually agreed upon by the parties, but no later than May 31st, 2021 so that the Work can be completed as expeditiously as practicable.
2. FPL shall pay AT&T the actual cost of the Work, which is estimated to be **Two Hundred Twenty Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty Five Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$220,855.50)** as shown in the attached **Exhibit B**. The estimated amount shall be due to AT&T upon the full execution of this agreement. FPL acknowledges that the estimated amount does not include rock removal costs and that if rock removal is required, the actual cost may exceed the estimated cost. Upon completion of the Work, AT&T will send a final invoice for their commercially reasonable out-of-pocket costs and expenses actually incurred as a result of AT&T’s scope of work as contemplated herein to FPL with customary documentation for such costs and expenses. If the actual cost is greater than the estimated amount, FPL will pay to AT&T the difference within thirty (30) days from the invoice date. If the actual cost is less than the estimated amount, AT&T shall reimburse FPL the difference within sixty (60) days from the invoice date.

3. FPL agrees to exercise all due caution while working near the Cable, in order to prevent damage to the Cable. FPL agrees:

(a) to notify AT&T by telephone at 1-800-252-1133 at least forty-eight (48) hours prior to performing any construction, demolition or repairs at the Cable location;

(b) not to use at the Cable location any tool, equipment, or the machinery capable of being operated within ten (10) feet of the Cable without an AT&T representative being present;

(c) to perform construction, demolition, repair, modifications, additions and any other activities in compliance with all applicable laws and regulations and in a manner that does not materially interfere with the operations of AT&T; and

(d) not to work at the Cable location without AT&T's prior authorization, which shall not be unreasonably withheld, denied or conditioned and AT&T's On-Site Work Force personnel being present during the work.

4. FPL (the "Indemnifying Party") shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless AT&T (the "Indemnified Party") from and against any and all claims, demands, actions, losses, damages, assessments, charges, judgments, liabilities, costs and expenses (including reasonable attorneys' fees and disbursements) that may from time to time be asserted by third parties against the Indemnified Party because of any personal injury, including death, to any person or loss of, physical damage to or loss of use of real or tangible personal property, to the extent caused by the negligence or willful misconduct of the Indemnifying Party, its agents, employees or contractors; except for the negligence or willful misconduct of the Indemnified Party. For purposes of indemnifications set forth in this Agreement, "Indemnified Party" means AT&T, its affiliates, subsidiaries, parent, successors and assigns and its and their employees, directors, officers, agents, contractors and subcontractors. The Indemnified Party:

4.1 shall notify the Indemnifying Party in writing promptly upon learning of any claim or suit for which indemnification may be sought, provided that failure to do so shall have no effect except to the extent the Indemnifying Party is prejudiced thereby;

4.2 shall have the right to participate in such defense or settlement with its own counsel and at its own expense, but the Indemnifying Party shall have control of this defense or settlement; and

4.3 shall reasonably cooperate with the defense.

5. AT&T makes no warranties, express or implied, including any implied warranties as to merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose.

6. Notwithstanding any provision of this agreement to the contrary, except as provided in Section 4, in no event shall either party be liable to the other party for any special, incidental, indirect, punitive, reliance or consequential damages, whether foreseeable or not, including, but not limited to, loss of profits or revenue, cost of capital, cost of replacement services, or claims of customers or of other third parties, occasioned by any cause whatsoever, including, without limitation, breach of contract, breach of warranty, negligence or strict liability.

7. FPL shall keep the Cable and other property of AT&T free from all mechanic's, artisan's, materialman's, architect's, or similar services' liens which arise in any way from or as a result of its activities and cause any such liens which may arise to be bonded, discharged or released.

8. Except for payment of the cost of the Work, neither party shall have any liability for its delays or its failure in performance due to: fire, explosion, pest damage, power failures, strikes or labor disputes, acts of God, the Elements, war, civil disturbances, acts of civil or military authorities or the public enemy, inability to secure raw materials, transportation facilities, fuel or energy shortages, or other causes beyond its control, whether or not similar to the foregoing.

9. A party shall be in default if it fails to perform or observe any material term or condition of this Agreement and the failure continues unremedied for thirty (30) days after receipt of written notice (fourteen (14) days in the case of FPL's failure to pay AT&T the estimated and/or actual cost of the Work); provided, however, that when such default (excluding FPL's non-payment) cannot reasonably be cured within such thirty (30) day period, this period will be extended if that party promptly commences to cure the same and prosecutes such curing with due diligence. Upon the default by a party, the other party may terminate this Agreement and pursue any legal remedies it may have under applicable law or principles of equity.

10. This Agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective successors or assigns. FPL shall not assign, transfer, or dispose of this Agreement or any of its rights or obligations hereunder without prior written consent of AT&T; provided, however, that FPL may assign or transfer this Agreement to a controlling or controlled affiliate or to a successor in the event of reorganization, including a merger or sale of substantially all of its assets, without the consent of AT&T. An assignment, transfer or disposition of this Agreement by FPL shall not relieve FPL of any of its obligations under this Agreement. AT&T shall have the right to assign this Agreement and to assign its rights and delegate its obligations and liabilities under this Agreement, either in whole or in part, to any party. An assignment, transfer or disposition of this Agreement by AT&T shall not relieve AT&T of any of its obligations under this Agreement. Neither this Agreement, nor any term or provision hereof, nor any inclusion by reference shall be construed as being for the benefit of any person or entity not a signatory hereto.

11. Any demand, notice or other communication to be given to a party in connection with this Agreement shall be given in writing and shall be given by personal delivery, by registered or certified mail, return receipt requested, or by commercial overnight delivery service addressed to the recipient as set forth below or to such other address or individual, as may be designated by notice given by the party to the other:

Any demand, notice or other communication given by personal delivery shall be conclusively deemed to have been given on the day of actual delivery thereof and if given by registered or certified mail, return receipt requested or by commercial overnight delivery service on the date of receipt thereof.

12. The failure of either party hereto to enforce any of the provisions of this Agreement, or the waiver thereof in any instance, shall not be construed as a general waiver or relinquishment on its part of any such provision, and said provision shall nevertheless be and remain in full force and effect.

13. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the domestic laws of the State of Florida without reference to its choice of law principles.

14. Each party represents and warrants that:

- (a) It has full right and authority to enter into, execute, deliver and perform its obligations under this Agreement;
- (b) It has taken all requisite corporate action to approve the execution, delivery and performance of this Agreement;
- (c) This Agreement constitutes a legal, valid and binding obligation enforceable against such party in accordance with its terms, subject to bankruptcy, insolvency, creditors' rights and general equitable principles; and
- (d) Its execution of and performance under this Agreement shall not violate any applicable existing regulations, rules, statutes, or court orders of any local, state or federal government agency, court or body.

15. This Agreement constitutes the entire and final agreement and understanding between the parties with respect to the subject matter hereof and supersedes all prior oral and written communications, understandings and agreements relating to the subject matter hereof, which are of no further force or effect. The Exhibits referred to herein are an integral part hereof and are hereby made a part of this Agreement. This Agreement may only be modified or supplemented by an instrument in writing executed by a duly authorized representative of each party.

16. Each action or claim against any party arising under or relating to this Agreement shall be made only against such party as a corporate, and any liability relating thereto shall be enforceable only against the corporate assets of such party. No party shall seek to pierce the corporate veil or otherwise seek to impose any liability relating to, or arising from, this Agreement against any shareholder, employee, officer or director of the other party. Each of such persons is an intended beneficiary of the mutual promises set forth in this Section 16 and shall be entitled to enforce the obligations of this Section 16.

17. The relationship between the parties shall not be that of partners, agents or joint ventures for one another, and nothing contained in this Agreement shall be deemed to constitute a partnership or agency agreement between them for any purposes, including, but not limited to federal income tax purposes. The parties, in performing any of their obligations hereunder, shall be independent contractors or independent parties and shall discharge their contractual obligations at their own risk.

18. This Agreement and each of the parties' respective rights and obligations under this Agreement shall be binding upon and shall inure to benefit of the parties and each of their respective permitted successors and assigns.

19. No provision of this Agreement shall be interpreted to require any unlawful action by either party. If any section or clause of this Agreement is held to be invalid or unenforceable, then the meaning of that section or clause shall be construed so as to

render it enforceable to the extent feasible. If no feasible interpretation would save the section or clause, it shall be severed from this Agreement with respect to the matter in question, and the remainder of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect. However, in the event such a section or clause is an essential element of the Agreement, the parties shall promptly negotiate a replacement that will achieve the intent of such unenforceable section or clause to the extent permitted by law.

20. This Agreement may be executed in one or more counterparts and electronically, all of shall be deemed original and when taken together shall constitute one and the same instrument.

Scope of Work

Date: March 29, 2021

PROJECT: FPL NFRC PROJECT, LAKE CITY, FLORIDA

The AT&T fiber optic cable installation located in Easement and crossing of a state highway and is necessitated by the FPL NRFC Project in Columbia County. To begin this project there will need to be 2,200 feet of duct proofing of an existing Permitted crossing of Highway 90. This project has 3,200 feet of directional bore and 6,100 feet Trenched in Place in total from one buried splice location to another. Placement of (6) split concrete manholes, placement of 10,000 feet of cable and 9,300 feet of mule tape in the spare conduit. This is along an AT&T Legacy T critical pathway between Ellisville to Valdosta to clear conflicts and re-cable AT&T Corp. critical route fiber in Columbia County, Florida.





1. THE CONTRACTOR IS REQUIRED TO CALL SUNSHINE 811, THE UNDERGROUND UTILITIES NOTIFICATION CENTER AT 1-800-432-4770, 2 FULL BUSINESS DAYS PRIOR TO ANY CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY.
2. ALL UTILITY LOCATIONS WERE TAKEN FROM THE BEST AVAILABLE SOURCES. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR LOCATING ALL UTILITIES IN THE FIELD PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION.
3. ALL CONSTRUCTION PROCEDURES SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STANDARD SPECIFICATION OF AT&T OUTSIDE PLANT SYSTEMS HANDBOOK.
4. ALL CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY SHALL BE PERFORMED IN THE PRESENCE OF AN AT&T TECHNICIAN OR REPRESENTATIVE.
5. IT SHALL BE NECESSARY FOR THE CONTRACTOR TO INSTALL THE AT&T BURIED AND CONDUIT SYSTEM TO REQUIRED GRADES AND OFFSETS AS DIRECTED BY THE CONSTRUCTION DRAWINGS. 


DETAIL HAND DIG CONDUIT UNDER EARTH OR GRAVEL




DIRECTIONAL BORE DETAILS




DIRECTIONAL BORE UNDER DRIVEWAY

DIRECTIONAL BORE UNDER CONTROLLED ACCESS STATE ROUTE







