Included in this submission are the following tariff pages for Quincy Telephone Company's Intrastate Access Services Tariff:

The purpose of this filing is to establish separate rate elements for intrastate Toll-Free Originating End Office Access Service. In addition, intrastate Switched End Office rates associated with 8YY traffic will be reduced to their functionally equivalent interstate rates (unless they are already lower) and all common transport charges associated with 8YY traffic will become subsumed into a single uniform rate (Joint Tandem Switched Transport) and capped at \$0.001. Finally, 8YY Query Charges will be capped at \$0.004248 per query. These modifications are in response to the Federal Communications Commission's Report and Order and Further Notice of Proposed rulemaking, WC Docket No. 18-156, FCC 20-143, § 51.909 (n) (Released October 9, 2020) that requires Rate of Return Carrier's to effectuate the preceding revisions, effective July 1, 2021. The Company views these tariff changes as administrative because they are consistent with the FCC's rules.

The proposed effective date for this tariff filing is **July 1, 2021**.

E. Determination of Premium Charges (continued)

- 5) The originating Premium Access per minute charge(s) apply to:
- all originating access minutes of use;
 - less those originating access minutes of use associated with FGA Access Services where the off-hook supervisory signaling is forwarded by the IXC's equipment when the called party answers;
 - less all originating access minutes of use associated with calls placed to 700, 800 and 900 numbers;
 - less those originating access minutes of use associated with Wireless Switching Centers (WSCs);
 - plus all originating access minutes of use associated with calls placed to 700, 800 series and 900 numbers for which the IXC furnishes for each month a report of either the number of calls or minutes or a report of the percent of calls or minutes that terminate in a Switched Access Service that is assessed Carrier Common Line charges, and for which a corresponding reduction in the number of terminating access minutes of use has been made as set forth in "4" preceding.
