ORDER APPROVING PLAN FOR HANDLING  
PROPRIETARY INFORMATION

BY THE COMMISSION:

United Telephone Long Distance, Inc. (UTLD) was granted authority to operate as an interexchange carrier by Order No. 18939. We determined, through an evidentiary hearing, that UTLD could offer its long distance services as an affiliate of United Telephone Company of Florida (UTF), subject to certain conditions. One of those conditions was that the companies file a report with us outlining how the proprietary information of competitive interexchange companies would be handled by UTF.

We have reviewed the plan describing the steps to be taken to insure that interexchange carrier proprietary information held by UTF will remain confidential. Upon consideration, we find that the guidelines constitute adequate safeguards and hereby approve the plan.

Therefore, based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that the plan submitted by United Telephone Company of Florida and United Telephone Long Distance, Inc. describing the steps that will be taken to insure that interexchange carrier information held by United Telephone Company of Florida will remain confidential is approved. It is further

ORDERED that this docket remain open.
