ORDER AMENDING CERTIFICATES TO INCLUDE
ADDITIONAL TERRITORY AND CLOSING DOCKET

BY THE COMMISSION:

On April 3, 1989, Southern States Utilities, Inc. (Southern States or Utility) filed an application with the Commission to amend its Certificates Nos. 209-W and 154-S to include additional territory in Pasco County, Florida, pursuant to the provisions of Section 367.061, Florida Statutes.

On approximately February 16, 1989, Southern States notified certificated utilities and appropriate governmental agencies in Pasco County of its intention to amend its Certificates to include the territory described in Appendix A, attached to this Order. Proof of Notification has been furnished by the Utility.

Notice of the Utility's intent to extend its service area was published in The Tampa Tribune, a newspaper of general circulation, published in Hillsborough County, Florida, on January 25, and February 1 and 8, 1989. No protests to this application were received within the prescribed time period.

The appropriate filing fee has been paid, and the Utility is ready, willing and able to provide service in the territory for which it has applied. The application has been reviewed and found to be in compliance with the statutory requirements. Accordingly, we find it is in the public interest to amend Certificates Nos. 209-W and 154-S to include the territory described in Appendix A to this Order, which by reference is incorporated herein.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Certificates Nos. 209-W and 154-S, held by Southern States Utilities, Inc., 1000 Color Place, Apopka, Florida 32703, are hereby amended to include the territory described in Appendix A of this Order. The Utility is directed to return Certificates Nos. 209-W and 154-S to this Commission within 20 days of the date of this Order for appropriate entry. It is further

ORDERED that the customers in the territory added herein shall be charged the rates approved in the Utility's tariff. It is further

ORDERED that Docket No. 890202-WS is hereby closed.

LEGAL DESCRIPTION

In Township 25 South, Range 16 East, Pasco County

Palm Terrace Gardens
(Water and Sewer Service)

All of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 10 except:
the South 470 feet, more or less, of
the East 440 feet more or less.

Also,

Executive Woods
(Water and Sewer Service)

The Northerly half of the East one-third of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 10.

Also,

Palm Terrace Estates
(Water and Sewer Service)

The Northerly 1000 feet, more or less, of the East one-third of the Northwest
1/4 of Section 15.

(Water only)

The Northerly 1000 feet, more or less, of the West two-thirds of the Northwest
1/4 of Section 15 except: the South 500 feet, more or less, of the West 360
feet, more or less.
