ORDER AMENDING CERTIFICATES TO INCLUDE
ADDITIONAL TERRITORY

BY THE COMMISSION:

On January 30, 1989, Sunray Utilities, Inc. (Sunray or Utility) filed an application with the Commission to amend its Certificates Nos. 502-W and 436-S to include additional territory in Nassau County, Florida, pursuant to the provisions of Section 367.061, Florida Statutes.

On August 17, 1988, Sunray notified certificated utilities and appropriate governmental agencies in Nassau County of its intention to amend its Certificates to include the territory described in Appendix A, attached to this Order. Proof of Notification has been furnished by the Utility.

Notice of the Utility's intent to extend its service area was published in the Fernandina Beach News-Leader, a newspaper of general circulation, published in Nassau County, Florida, on August 24 and 31, and September 7, 1988. No protests to this application were received within the prescribed time period.

The appropriate filing fee has been paid, and the Utility is ready, willing and able to provide service in the territory for which it has applied. The application has been reviewed and found to be in compliance with the statutory requirements. Accordingly, we find it is in the public interest to amend Certificates Nos. 502-W and 436-S to include the territory described in Appendix A to this Order, which by reference is incorporated herein.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Certificates Nos. 502-W and 436-S, held by Sunray Utilities, Inc., 31 South 4th Street, Post Office Box 1708, Fernandina Beach, Florida 32034, are hereby amended to include the territory described in Appendix A of this Order. The Utility is directed to return Certificates Nos. 502-W and 436-S to this Commission within 20 days of the date of this Order for appropriate entry. It is further

ORDERED that the customers in the territory added herein shall be charged the rates approved in the Utility's tariff. It is further

ORDERED that Docket No. 890158-WS is hereby closed.
