ORDER GRANTING EXTENSIONS OF TIME FOR FILING TAX REPORTS PURSUANT TO RULE 25-14.003(4), F.A.C.

BY THE COMMISSION:

Rule 25-14.003(4), Florida Administrative Code, provides that on or before March 1st of every year following a tax rate change, each utility shall furnish a final tax report. By Order No. 20852, issued March 3, 1989, we gave Commission staff authority to administratively grant a sixty-day extension of the filing deadline upon written request received no later than the March 1 filing date.

Staff mailed the report forms to Beacon Twenty-one Development Corp. (Beacon), Edgewater Utilities, Inc. (Edgewater), and K.S. Operations (K.S.) on January 19, 1989. The reports were returned because the addresses were incorrect, through no fault of the utilities. Correct addresses were obtained and the forms were mailed again to K.S. on February 28, 1989, and to Beacon and Edgewater on March 29, 1989. The utilities did not have sufficient time to file their reports or request extensions.

Based on the foregoing, we find it appropriate to waive the filing deadline in Rule 25-14.003(4), Florida Administrative Code, for the utilities listed above, and grant them extensions until June 30, 1989, to file their tax reports.


It is, therefore,

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that the filing deadline in Rule 25-14.003(4), Florida Administrative Code, is hereby waived for Beacon Twenty-one Development Corp., Edgewater Utilities, Inc., and K.S. Operations, Inc., and extensions are granted until June 30, 1989, for filing their tax reports.
