ORDER ACKNOWLEDGING SALE, CANCELLING CERTIFICATE  
AND CLOSING DOCKET

BY THE COMMISSION:

The Vineyards Utility, Inc. (The Vineyards or Utility) has heretofore operated its water and sewer systems under the jurisdiction of the Florida Public Service Commission, providing service to certain territory in Collier County, Florida.

On November 1, 1988, Collier County Government acquired The Vineyards at no cost. The records were transferred to Collier County on the closing date. The Vineyards overpaid its regulatory assessment fees for 1988. Upon determination by the Commission of the amount of the over-payment, that amount will be remitted to the Vineyards. There are no dockets pending involving this system.

The provisions of Section 367.071, Florida Statutes, require an application for approval of sales of water and/or sewer utilities to governmental agencies, although such sales are approved as a matter of right. Subsection 367.022(2), Florida Statutes, exempts from regulation by the Commission systems owned, operated, managed, or controlled by governmental agencies.

On the basis of the foregoing, we have determined that Certificate No. 489-W should be cancelled. It is, therefore,

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that the sale of The Vineyards Utility, Inc., 20 Napa Boulevard, Naples, Florida 33999, to Collier County Government, 2333-2337 Airport Road South, Naples, Florida 33942, is hereby acknowledged. It is further

ORDERED that Certificate No. 489-W is hereby cancelled. The Utility is directed to return Certificate No. 489-W to this Commission for cancellation within 20 days from the date of this Order. It is further

ORDERED that Docket No. 890318-WU is hereby closed.
