ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION

BY THE COMMISSION:

By Petition, Volusia County, Florida, has requested permission to intervene in this proceeding. Volusia is a charter county government created under Article VIII, Section 1(g) of the Florida Constitution and the Laws of Florida with home rule power within Volusia County. Volusia County alleges that its substantial interests will be affected by any action taken in this matter because it is considering the acquisition of the Deltona Lakes water and sewer service facilities of Deltona Utilities, Inc. Volusia's concern is primarily to ensure that there will be no increase in the cost requirements for the Citizens of Volusia County by Topeka's acquisition. Having reviewed the Petition, we find that it should be granted.

Based on the foregoing, it is, therefore,

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that the Petition for Leave to Intervene filed by Volusia County is hereby granted. It is further
