AMENDATORY ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On August 11, 1989, Florida Pay Telephone Association, Inc. (FPTA) filed a document with this Commission entitled "Motion to Reconsider, Clarify, or Stay Portions of Order No. 21614," along with a Request for Oral Argument on this motion.

By Order No. 21813, issued August 31, 1989, the Prehearing Officer denied FPTA's Request for Oral Argument. In the body of Order No. 21813, the Prehearing Officer noted that timely responses to FPTA's motion were filed by Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company (Southern Bell) and United Telephone Company of Florida (United).

Shortly after issuance of Order No. 21813, it came to our attention that a timely response to FPTA's motion was also filed by GTE Florida Incorporated (GTEFL). Like the responses filed by Southern Bell and United, the GTEFL response urges that FPTA's motion, as well as the Request for Oral Argument thereupon, be denied.

Upon review, we find that GTEFL's timely response to FPTA's motion should have been noted in the body of Order No. 21813.

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Order No. 21813 is amended to the extent outlined in the body of this Order. It is further

ORDERED that Order No. 21813 is affirmed in all other respects. It is further

ORDERED that this docket shall remain open.
