ORDER REQUIRING UTILITY TO ISSUE A SECOND NOTICE TO ITS CUSTOMERS

Pursuant to the Order Establishing Procedure in this matter, Order No. 21863, issued September 8, 1989, Sunshine Utilities was ordered to issue an informational notice to its customers regarding this proceeding within thirty days of that Order. The utility submitted such notice for our review on September 22, 1989, which we subsequently approved. However, it has come to our attention through customer letters, that the printing of at least some of the copies of this notice issued by the utility was of such poor quality that the customers were unable to read it. For this reason, we hereby require the utility to issue a second informational notice to its customers, such as we have previously approved, within ten days of the issuance of this Order. In addition, we will require a report to be submitted by the utility, attaching the original copy of this second informational notice and an example of the duplicated copy sent to the customers, as well as setting out the date of mailing and the total number of customers who were mailed this second notice.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED by COMMISSIONER BETTY EASLEY, as Prehearing Officer, that Sunshine Utilities shall send a second informational notice to its customers and a report to this Commission as set forth in the body of this Order.
