ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME
TO PREFILE TESTIMONY

By Order No. 21631, issued August 2, 1989, this Commission approved the transfer of Certificates Nos. 187-W and 131-S from Twin County Utility Company (Twin County) to Southern States Utilities, Inc. (Southern States). In addition, by Order No. 21631, we proposed to deny certain portions of a developer agreement related to the transfer and to require Southern States to file an amended developer agreement.

Pursuant to Twin County's and Southern States' protest of Order No. 21631, this case is currently set for an administrative hearing.

By Order No. 21975, issued September 29, 1989, a schedule was established to govern the key activities of this case. Currently, Southern States and Twin County are scheduled to prefile their direct testimony and exhibits on or before December 20, 1989.

On December 15, 1989, Southern States and Twin County filed a joint motion for an extension of time to prefile their testimony. According to their motion, the parties have reached a tentative agreement on amendments to the developer agreement, which they believe will satisfy this Commission. Accordingly, the parties have requested an extension of time, until January 15, 1990, to prefile their direct testimony, in order that they may finalize these amendments.

Upon consideration, it does not appear that granting the parties' request will adversely affect the schedule for this case. Their motion for extension of time is, therefore, granted. All other provisions of Order No. 21975 remain unaffected by this Order.


