ORDER ON CONFIDENTIALITY

By letter dated November 10, 1989, Gulf Power Company sought partial confidential treatment of the information contained in its FPSC Fuel Report Form 423 for November 1989. By letter dated November 28, 1989, the Company withdrew its request for confidential treatment of that filing. The Company also withdrew any earlier requests for confidential treatment relating to FPSC Form 423 for which an order resolving the request had not yet been entered by the Commission.

In consideration of the foregoing, it is

ORDERED that Gulf Power Company has withdrawn all requests for confidential treatment relating to FPSC Form 423 filed by the Company up to and including November, 1989, for which an order resolving said request has not been entered by the Commission. It is further

ORDERED that if a protest is filed within 14 days of the date of this order it will be resolved by the appropriate Commission panel pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3)(d), Florida Administrative Code.
