AMENDATORY ORDER

On March 1, 1990, we issued Order No. 22620 suspending the utility's proposed rates and granting an interim increase in water rates. In that order, we inadvertently stated the wrong effective date for the interim water rates. Accordingly, we hereby correct the first sentence on page 6 to read as follows: The interim water rates will become effective for service rendered on or after the stamped approval date on the revised tariff sheets, as Southern States' Seminole County systems are on a bi-monthly billing cycle.

Likewise, we hereby correct the second ordering paragraph on page 7 of the order to state: ORDERED that the interim water rates will be effective for service rendered on or after the stamped approval date on the revised tariff sheets.

It is therefore,

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Order No. 22620 is hereby amended as set forth above. It is further

ORDERED that Order No. 22620 is hereby affirmed in all other respects.
