BY THE COMMISSION:

By Order No. 23447, issued September 6, 1990, we granted American Long Distance, Co. (ALDC) a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing it to provide interexchange telecommunications service in Florida. By Order No. 23448, issued September 6, 1990, we also ordered ALDC to show cause, in writing, why a penalty of \$2500 should not be assessed against it for providing interexchange service since July, 1989, before obtaining the necessary certificate. On December 24, 1990, ALDC remitted the amount of the penalty to the Commission. Therefore, since ALDC has satisfied the requirements of the show cause order, this docket shall be closed.
