ORDER CLOSING DOCKETS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By Order No. 24309, issued April 1, 1991, we denied Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company's (the Company) Open Network Architecture (ONA) tariff as filed. However, the Order informed the Company that if it refiled the tariff without offering Automatic Number Identification (ANI) feature, the tariff would be approved administratively. The Company subsequently refiled its ONA tariff without the ANI feature.

However, the Company also excluded features that had been part of the original filing. These features are: Uniform Access Number, Trunk Side Access Facility, Custom Service Area, and Call Detail Information. Southern Bell asserts that without ANI, there is no demand for these four offerings. But, the Company will continue to evaluate the demand for these services. We believe that the Company's course of action is reasonable. The reporting requirements for ONA service requests and subscription rates, as set forth in Order No. 24309, shall continue. Additionally, future ONA filings shall be addressed in separate proceedings. Therefore, we believe it is appropriate to close these dockets.

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Dockets Nos. 880423-TL and 881323-TL are hereby closed. It is further
