AMENDATORY ORDER

By Order No. 25367 the Commission directed Southern Bell to refund excess accrued revenues stemming from our prior decisions in this docket. The Order provided, inter alia, that refunds would be granted to customers of Southern Bell who received service during 1990 but were not customers of record on December 31, 1990 and who could substantiate their request for a refund. The Order inadvertently omitted our requirement that all such requests for refund be made within 30 days of the date of issuance of our decision regarding the refund. Accordingly, the following language should be added to the third full paragraph of Order No. 25367:

Claims for refunds by customers not of record on December 31, 1990, must be submitted to Southern Bell within 30 days of the date of issuance of the Order requiring a refund. All such claims shall be factored into the projected units for the refund to determine the refund factor applicable to all customers.

In accordance with our requirements set forth in language above, customers not of record seeking a refund shall submit their requests to Southern Bell within 30 days of the date of issuance of Order No. 25367.

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Order No. 25367 is amended as set forth in the body of this Order. It is further

ORDERED that Order No. 25367 is hereby affirmed in all other respects.
