ORDER GRANTING MOTIONS FOR
EXTENSION OF TIME

By Order No. PSC-93-0512-PCO-TL, issued April 5, 1993, we directed ALLTEL Florida, Inc. (ALLTEL), BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company (Southern Bell), and United Telephone Company of Florida (United) to perform certain traffic studies. We ordered the companies to perform these traffic studies so that we could further evaluate Resolution No. 93-R-20 filed with this Commission by the Marion County Board of County Commissioners. This Resolution requested that we consider requiring extended area service (EAS) between all exchanges in Marion County. Marion County contains the following exchanges or portions of exchanges: Belleview, Citra, Dunnellon, Forest, Lady Lake, McIntosh, Micanopy, Ocala, Oklawaha, Orange Springs, Salt Springs, Silver Springs Shores, Umatilla, and Williston. The Citra, McIntosh, and Orange Springs exchanges are served by ALLTEL; the Dunnellon and Micanopy exchanges are served by Southern Bell; and the remaining exchanges are served by United. The companies were directed to prepare and submit the studies to us within 90 days of the issuance date of our Order, making the studies due by July 6, 1993.

On May 21, 1993, United filed a Motion for Extension of Time requesting an extension through and including September 5, 1993, in which to prepare and submit the required traffic studies. As grounds for its request, United states that during the same general time period the Order described above was issued, United was also ordered to provide traffic studies in three other dockets. In this particular docket, United will be required to study 117 individual routes. United has estimated that as many as 200 data runs will be required to complete the study, making this study amongst the largest ever undertaken by United. United asserts that the work required for all these dockets has overwhelmed its traffic study group, necessitating this request for an extension of time.

On July 6, 1993, Southern Bell filed a Motion for Extension of Time requesting an extension through and including August 4, 1993, in which to prepare and submit the required traffic studies. As grounds for its request, Southern Bell states that it performed the traffic studies as ordered but they appear to be at least partially

in error. Southern Bell asserts that it needs an additional 30 days in which to determine the cause of the error and to remedy the problem.

Upon consideration, I find it appropriate to grant both Motions. Accordingly, United and Southern Bell shall be granted extensions of time until the close of business on September 7, 1993 (September 5 and 6 are both holidays), and August 4, 1993, respectively, in which to prepare and submit the required traffic studies.

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by Chairman J. Terry Deason, as Acting Prehearing Officer, that the Motion for Extension of Time filed on May 21, 1993, by United Telephone Company of Florida is hereby granted. It is further

ORDERED that the Motion for Extension of Time filed on July 6, 1993, by BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company is hereby granted. It is further

ORDERED that United Telephone Company of Florida shall file the required traffic study data on or before September 7, 1993. It is further

ORDERED that BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company shall file the required traffic study data on or before August 4, 1993.

NOTICE OF FURTHER PROCEEDINGS OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

The Florida Public Service Commission is required by Section 120.59(4), Florida Statutes, to notify parties of any administrative hearing or judicial review of Commission orders that is available under Sections 120.57 or 120.68, Florida Statutes, as well as the procedures and time limits that apply. This notice should not be construed to mean all requests for an administrative hearing or judicial review will be granted or result in the relief sought.

Any party adversely affected by this order, which is preliminary, procedural or intermediate in nature, may request: (1) reconsideration within 10 days pursuant to Rule 25-22.038(2), Florida Administrative Code, if issued by a Prehearing Officer; (2) reconsideration within 15 days pursuant to Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code, if issued by the Commission; or (3) judicial review by the Florida Supreme Court, in the case of an electric, gas or telephone utility, or the First District Court of Appeal, in the case of a water or wastewater utility. A motion for reconsideration shall be filed with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting, in the form prescribed by Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code. Judicial review of a preliminary, procedural or intermediate ruling or order is available if review of the final action will not provide an adequate remedy. Such review may be requested from the appropriate court, as described above, pursuant to Rule 9.100, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.
