
ORDER APPROVING COLLOCATION AGREEMENT

BY THE COMMISSION:

On January 6, 1998 BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (BellSouth) and TCG South Florida (TCG) filed a request for approval of an amendment to the existing collocation agreement under the Telecommunications Act of 1996, 47 U.S.C. \$252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act). The agreement is attached to this Order as Attachment A and incorporated by reference herein.

Both the Act and Chapter 364, Florida Statutes, encourage parties to enter into negotiated agreements to bring about local exchange competition as quickly as possible. Under the requirements of 47 U.S.C. § 252(e), negotiated agreements must be submitted to the state commission for approval. Section 252(e)(4) requires the state to reject or approve the agreement within 90 days after submission or it shall be deemed approved.

The amendment to the existing agreement covers a 2-year period and governs the relationship between the companies regarding physical collocation services under 47 U.S.C. § 251. The agreement states that collocation space will be provided for TCG in



BellSouth's Central Office. Rates for the collocation space and telecommunications services are set out in the attached schedules.

Upon review of the proposed agreement, we believe that it complies with the Telecommunications Act of 1996; thus, we hereby approve it. The Commission's approval of this agreement should not be construed as a determination that BellSouth has met the requirements of Section 271 of the Act. BellSouth and TCG are also required to file any subsequent supplements or modifications to their agreement with the Commission for review under the provisions of 47 U.S.C. § 252(e).

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that the collocation agreement between BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. and TCG South Florida, as set forth in Attachment A and incorporated by reference in this Order, is hereby approved. It is further

ORDERED that any supplements or modifications to this agreement must be filed with the Commission for review under the provisions of 47 U.S.C. § 252(e). It is further

ORDERED that this docket shall be closed.



Description:

Buildouth shall allow TCO to assess the following Loop types (in addition to those Loops evaluate under applicable sariffs) unbundled from local switching and local straspers in assessment with the series and conditions out forth horses:

"J-Wire ISBN Bigins Grade Leape" which support digital transmission of two 64 Kips beaver channels and one 16 Kips date channels. This is a 29+D Basic Rate learning languaged Services Digital Network (BRJ-ISDN) type of loop which will most surjoin ISDN standards.

"3-Wire ABEL-Compatible Loop" or "ADEL 2W" is a transmission path which facilitates the transmission of up to a 6-Mips digital eigend development (several the Customer) and up to a 6-Mips digital eigend adversaries (several distributions) while elements overly corrying an analog voice agend. "4-Why ISSEL-Compatible Loop" or "IEDSL 4W" is a treasmission path which finitiones the transmission of a 1.544 https://distr.org.compared over two 2-wise non-located revised copper poors moreing the specifications in ANSI TIEI Committee Technical Report Number 28. NDSL compatible Loop are available only where existing copper ficilities can most the specifications.

"Entegrated Digital Loop Corvier" or "Entegrated DLC" is the same as Digital Loop Corner, except it is not demoloplesed, but instead the DS-1 facilities are directly connected into compatible digital equipment.
