### ORDER APPROVING AMENDMENT TO EXISTING RESALE AGREEMENT

BY THE COMMISSION:

On July 13, 1998, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (BST) and NeTel, Inc. d/b/a TEL3 (TEL3) filed a request for approval of an amendment to the existing resale agreement under 47 U.S.C. \$252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act). The amendment to the existing agreement is attached to this Order as Attachment A and incorporated by reference herein.

Both the Act and Chapter 364, Florida Statutes, encourage parties to enter into negotiated agreements to bring about local exchange competition as quickly as possible. Under the requirements of 47 U.S.C. § 252(e), negotiated agreements must be submitted to the state commission for approval. Section 252(e)(4) requires the state to reject or approve the agreement within 90 days after submission or it shall be deemed approved.

The existing agreement governs the relationship between the companies regarding the resale of tariffed telecommunication

services. Under 47 U.S.C. § 252(a) (1), the agreement shall include a detailed schedule of itemized charges for interconnection and each service or network element included in the agreement. Upon review of the proposed amendment to the existing agreement, we believe that it complies with the Act; thus, we hereby approve it. BST and TEL3 are also required to file any subsequent supplements or modifications to their agreement with the Commission for review under the provisions of 47 U.S.C. § 252(e).

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that the amendment to the existing resale agreement between BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. and NeTel, Inc. d/b/a TEL3, as set forth in Attachment A and incorporated by reference in this Order, is hereby approved. It is further

ORDERED that any supplements or modifications to this agreement must be filed with the Commission for review under the provisions of 47 U.S.C. § 252(e). It is further

ORDERED that this Docket shall be closed.

### AMENDMENT TO RESALE AGREEMENT BETWEEN NETEL, INC. TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC. AND BELLSOUTH TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC. DATED JULY 11, 1997

Pursuant to this Agreement (the "Amendment"), NeTel, Inc. ("NeTel") and BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth") hereinafter referred to collectively as the "Parties" hereby agree to amend that certain Resale Agreement between the Parties dated July 11, 1997 ("Resale Agreement").

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual provisions contained herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, NeTel. Inc. and BellSouth hereby covenant and agree as follows:

- NeTel, Inc. hereby amends the above mentioned Resale Agreement to reflect the name change of NeTel, Inc. to NeTel, Inc. d/b/a TEL3.
- 2. Effective <u>6-9-98</u>, the NeTel, Inc. Resale Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein by this reference, shall be between NeTel, Inc. d/b/a TEL3 and BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc.
- The Parties further agree that either or both of the Parties is authorized to submit this Amendment to the appropriate Public Service Commissions for approval subject to Section 252(e) of the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996.

Agreement Between BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. and Netel, Inc. Regarding The Sale of BellSouth Telecommunications Services to Netel, Inc. For The Purposes of Resale

THIS AGREEMENT is by and between BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., ("BellSouth or Company"), a Georgia corporation, and Netel, Inc. ("Netel"), a Delaware corporation, and shall be deemed effective as of July 11.

#### WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, BellSouth is a local exchange telecommunications company authorized to provide telecommunications services in the states of Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, Netel is or seeks to become an alternative local exchange telecommunications company authorized to provide telecommunications services in the states of Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Kamucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, Netel desires to resell BellSouth's telecommunications services; and

WHEREAS, BellSouth has agreed to provide such services to Netel for resale purposes and pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the munual premises and promises contained herein, BellSouth and Netel do hereby agree as follows:

### L Term of the Agreement

- A. The term of this Agreement shall be two years beginning July 11, 1997 and shall apply to all of BellSouth's serving territory as of January 1, 1997 in the states of Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Kennucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Tennessee.
- B. This Agreement shall be automatically renewed for two additional one year periods unless either party indicates its intent not to renew the Agreement. Notice of such intent must be provided, in writing, to the other party no later than 60 days prior to the end of the then-existing contract period. The terms of this Agreement shall remain in effect after the term of the existing agreement has expired and while a new agreement is being negotiated.
- C. The rates pursuant by which Netel is to purchase services from BellSouth for resale shall be at a discount rate off of the retail rate for the telecommunications service. The discount rates shall be as set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference. Such discount shall reflect the costs avoided by BellSouth when selling a service for wholesale purposes.

### IL Definition of Terms.

- A. CUSTOMER OF RECORD means the entity responsible for placing application for service; requesting additions, rearrangements, maintenance or discontinuance of service; payment in full of charges incurred such as non-recurring, monthly recurring, toll, directory assistance, etc.
- B. DEPOSIT means assurance provided by a customer in the form of cash, surety bond or bank letter of credit to be held by the Company.

- C. END USER means the ultimate user of the telecommunications services
- makes use of the telecommunications services. END USER CUSTOMER LOCATION means the physical location of the premises where an end user

- telecommunications service. H. RESALE SERVICE AREA means the area, as defined in a public service commission approved certificate of operation, within which an OLEC, such as Netel, may offer resold local exchange

### III. General Provisions

Netel may not purchase telecommunications services at the wholesale rate for its own use. specifically set forth herein. Norwithstanding the foregoing, the exclusions and limitations on services available for resale will be as set forth in Exhibit B, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference. In addition, A. Netel may resell the tariffed local exchange and toll telecommunications services of BellSouth contained in the General Subscriber Service Tariff and Private Line Service Tariff subject to the terms, and conditions

It does not however waive its rights to appeal or otherwise challenge any decision regarding resale that resulted in the discount rates contained in Exhibit B. BellSouth reserves the right to pursue any and all legal and/or equitable remedies, including appeals of any decisions. If such appeals or challenges result in changes in the discount rates or exclusions and limitations, the parties agree that appropriate modifications to this Agreement will be made promptly to make its terms consistent with the outcome BellSouth shall make available telecommunications services for resale at the rates set forth in Exhibit A to this

- D. Netel will be the Company's single point of contact for all services purchased pursuant to this Agreement The Company shall have no contact with the end user except to the examt provided for herein.

- E. The Company will continue to bill the end user for any services that the end user specifies it wishes to receive directly from the Company.
- F. The Company maintains the right to serve directly any end user within the service area of Netel. The Company will continue to directly market its own telecommunications products and services and in doing so may establish independent relationships with end users of Netel.
- G. Neither Party shall interfere with the right of any person or entity to obtain service directly from the other Party.
- H. Current telephone numbers may normally be retained by the end user. However, telephone numbers are the property of the Company and are assigned to the service furnished. Netel has no property right to the telephone number or any other call number designation associated with services furnished by the Company, and no right to the continuance of service through any perticular central office. The Company reserves the right to change such numbers, or the central office designation associated with such numbers, or both, whenever the Company deems it necessary to do so in the conduct of its business.
- I. The Company may provide any service or facility for which a charge is not established herein, as long as it is offered on the same terms to Netel.
- Service is furnished subject to the condition that it will not be used for any unlawful purpose.
- K. Service will be discontinued if any law enforcement agency advises that the service being used is in violation of the law.
- L. The Company can refuse service when it has grounds to believe that service will be used in violation of the law.
- M. The Company accepts no responsibility to any person for any unlawful act committed by Netel or its end users as part of providing service to Netel for purposes of resale or otherwise.
- N. The Company will cooperate fully with law enforcement agencies with subpoenas and court orders for assistance with the Company's customers. Law enforcement agency subpoenas and court orders regarding end users of Netsi will be directed to Netsi. The Company will bill Netsi for implementing any requests by law enforcement agencies regarding Netsi end users.
- O. The characteristics and methods of operation of any circuits, facilities or equipment provided by any person or entity other than the Company shall not:
  - 1. Interfere with or impair service over any facilities of the Company, its affiliates, or its connecting and concurring carriers involved in its service;
  - 2. Cause damage to their plant;
  - 3. Impair the privacy of any communications; or

# IV. BellSouth's Provision of Services to Netal

- A. Netel agrees that its resale of BellSouth services shall be as follows:

This subsection shall be void and of no effect for a particular state covered under this Agreement as of February 8, 1999 or on the date BellSouth is authorized to offer interLATA services in that state, whichever is earlier.
- Hotel and Hospital PBX service are the only telecommunications services available for resale to Hotel/Motel and Hospital end users, respectively. Similarly, Access Line Service for Customer Provided

Coin Telephones is the only local service available for resale to Independent Payphone Provider (IPP) customers. Shared Tenant Service customers can only be sold those telecommunications services available in the Company's A23 Shared Tenant Service Tariff.

- 4. Netel is prohibited from furnishing both flat and measured rate service on the same business premises to the same subscribers (end users) as stated in A2 of the Company's Tariff except for backup service as indicated in the applicable state tariff Section A3.
- 5. If telephone service is established and it is subsequently determined that the class of service restriction has been violated, Netel will be notified and billing for that service will be immediately changed to the appropriate class of service. Service charges for changes between class of service, back billing, and interest as described in this subsection shall apply at the Company's sole discretion. Interest at a rate as set forth in Section A2 of the General Subscriber Service Tariff and Section B2 of the Private Line Service Tariff for the applicable state, compounded daily for the number of days from the back billing date to and including the date that Netel actually makes the payment to the Company may be assessed.
- 6. The Company reserves the right to periodically audit services purchased by Netel to establish authenticity of use. Such audit shall not occur more than once in a calendar year. Netel shall make any and all records and data available to the Company or the Company's auditors on a reasonable basis. The Company shall bear the cost of said audit.
- B. Resold services can only be used in the same manner as specified in the Company's Tariff. Resold services are subject to the same terms and conditions as are specified for such services when furnished to an individual end user of the Company in the appropriate section of the Company's Tariffs. Specific tariff features, e.g. a usage allowance per month, shall not be aggregated across multiple resold services. Resold services cannot be used to aggregate traffic from more than one end user customer except as specified in Section A23. of the Company's Tariff referring to Shared Tenant Service.
- C. Netel may resell services only within the specific resale service area as defined in its certificate.
- D. Telephone numbers transmitted via any resold service feature are intended solely for the use of the end user of the feature. Resale of this information is prohibited.
- E. No patent, copyright, trademark or other proprietary right is licensed, granted or otherwise transferred by this Agreement. Notel is strictly prohibited from any use, including but not limited to sales, marketing or advertising, of any BellSouth name or trademark.

### V. Maintenance of Services

- A. Netel will adopt and adhere to the standards contained in the applicable BellSouth Work Center Interface Agreement regarding maintenance and installation of service.
- B. Services resold under the Company's Tariffs and facilities and equipment provided by the Company shall be maintained by the Company.

- C. Netel or its end users may not rearrange, move, disconnect, remove or attempt to repair any facilities owned by the Company, other than by connection or disconnection to any interface means used, except with the written consent of the Company.
- D. Netel accepts responsibility to notify the Company of situations that arise that may result in a service problem.
- E. Netel will be the Company's single point of contact for all repair calls on behalf of Netel's end users.
  The parties agree to provide one another with toll-free contact numbers for such purposes.
- F. Netel will contact the appropriate repair centers in accordance with procedures established by the Company.
- G. For all repair requests, Netel accepts responsibility for adhering to the Company's prescreening guidelines prior to referring the trouble to the Company.
- H. The Company will bill Nete! for handling troubles that are found not to be in the Company's network pursuant to its standard time and material charges. The standard time and material charges will be no more than what BellSouth charges to its retail customers for the same services.
- L The Company reserves the right to contact. Netel's customers, if deemed necessary, for maintenance purposes.

#### VI. Establishment of Service

- A. After receiving certification as a local exchange company from the appropriate regulatory agency, Netel will provide the appropriate Company service center the necessary documentation to enable the Company to establish a master account for Netel. Such documentation shall include the Application for Master Account, proof of authority to provide telecommunications services, an Operating Company Number ("OCN") assigned by the National Exchange Carriers Association ("NECA") and a tax exemption certificate, if applicable. When necessary deposit requirements are met, the Company will begin taking orders for the resale of service.
- B. Service orders will be in a standard format designated by the Company.
- C. When notification is received from Netel that a current customer of the Company will subscribe to Netel's service, standard service order intervals for the appropriate class of service will apply.
- D. The Company will not require end user confirmation prior to establishing service for Netal's end user customer. Netal must, however, be able to demonstrate end user authorization upon request.
- E. Netel will be the single point of contact with the Company for all subsequent ordering activity resulting in additions or changes to resold services except that the Company will accept a request directly from the end user for conversion of the end user's service from Netel to the Company or will accept a request from another OLEC for conversion of the end user's service from the Netel to the other LEC. The Company will notify Netel that such a request has been processed.

- F. If the Company determines that an unauthorized change in local service to Netel has occurred, the Company will reestablish service with the appropriate local service provider and will assess Netel as the OLEC initiating the unauthorized change, the unauthorized change charge described in F.C.C. Tariff No. 1, Section 13. Appropriate nonrecurring charges, as set forth in Section A4, of the General Subscriber Service Tariff, will also be assessed to Netel. These charges can be adjusted if Netel provides satisfactory proof of authorization.
- G. The Company will, in order to safeguard its interest, require Netel to make a deposit to be held by the Company as a guarantee of the payment of rates and charges, unless satisfactory credit has already been established. Any such deposit may be held during the continuance of the service as security for the payment of any and all amounts accruing for the service.
- H. Such deposit may not exceed two months' estimated billing.
- I. The fact that a deposit has been made in no way relieves Netel from complying with the Company's regulations as to advance payments and the prompt payment of bills on presentation nor does it constitute a waiver or modification of the regular practices of the Company providing for the discontinuance of service for non-payment of any sums due the Company.
- J. The Company reserves the right to increase the deposit requirements when, in its sole judgment, the conditions justify such action.
- K. In the event that Netel defaults on its account, service to Netel will be terminated and any deposits held will be applied to its account.
- L. In the case of a cash deposit, interest at the rate of six percent per annum shall be paid to Netel during the continuance of the deposit. Interest on a deposit shall accrue annually and, if requested, shall be annually credited to Netel by the accrual date.

#### VII. Payment And Billing Arrangements

- A. When the initial service is ordered by Netel, the Company will establish an accounts receivable master account for Netel.
- B. The Company shall bill Need on a current basis all applicable charges and credits.
- C. Payment of all charges will be the responsibility of Netel. Notel shall make payment to the Company for all services billed. The Company is not responsible for payments not received by Netel from Netel's customer. The Company will not become involved in billing disputes that may arise between Netel and its customer. Payments made to the Company as payment on account will be credited to an accounts receivable master account and not to an end user's account.
- D. The Company will render bills each month on established bill days for each of Netel's accounts.
- E. The Company will bill Netel, in advance, charges for all services to be provided during the ensuing billing period except charges associated with service usage, which charges will be billed in arrears. Charges will be calculated on an individual end user account level, including, if applicable, any charges for usage or usage

allowances. BellSouth will also bill all charges, including but not limited to 911 and E911 charges, telecommunications relay charges, and franchise fees, to Netel.

F. The payment will be due by the next bill date (i.e., same date in the following month as the bill date) and is payable in immediately available funds. Payment is considered to have been made when received by the Company.

If the payment due date falls on a Sunday or on a Holiday which is observed on a Monday, the payment due date shall be the first non-Holiday day following such Sunday or Holiday. If the payment due date falls on a Saturday or on a Holiday which is observed on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, or Friday, the payment due date shall be the last non-Holiday day preceding such Saturday or Holiday. If payment is not received by the payment due date, a late payment penalty, as set forth in I. following, shall apply.

- G. Upon proof of tax exempt certification from Netel, the total amount billed to Netel will not include any taxes due from the end user. Netel will be solely responsible for the computation, tracking, reporting and payment of all federal, state and/or local jurisdiction taxes associated with the services resold to the end user.
- H. As the customer of record, Netel will be responsible for, and remit to the Company, all charges applicable to its resold services for emergency services (E911 and 911) and Telecommunications Relay Service (TRS) as well as any other charges of a similar nature.
- I. If any portion of the payment is received by the Company after the payment due date as set forth preceding, or if any portion of the payment is received by the Company in funds that are not immediately available to the Company, then a late payment penalty shall be due to the Company. The late payment penalty shall be the portion of the payment not received by the payment due date times a late factor. The late factor shall be as set forth in Section A2 of the General Subscriber Service Tariff and Section B2 of the Private Line Service Tariff.
- J. Any switched access charges associated with interexchange carrier access to the resold local exchange lines will be billed by, and due to, the Company. No additional charges are to be assessed to Netel.
- K. The Company will not perform billing and collection services for Netel as a result of the execution of this Agreement. All requests for billing services should be referred to the appropriate entity or operational group within the Company.
- L. Pursuant to 47 CFR Section 51.617, the Company will bill Netel end user common line charges identical to the end user common line charges the Company bills its end users.
- M. In general, the Company will not become involved in disputes between Netel and Netel's end user customers over resold services. If a dispute does arise that cannot be settled without the involvement of the Company, Netel shall contact the designated Service Center for resolution. The Company will make every effort to assist in the resolution of the dispute and will work with Netel to resolve the matter in as timely a manner as possible. Netel may be required to submit documentation to substantiate the claim.

### VIII. Discontinuance of Service

A. The procedures for discontinuing service to an end user are as follows:

- 1. Where possible, the Company will deny service to Netel's end user on behalf of, and at the request of, netel. Upon restoration of the end user's service, restoral charges will apply and will be the
- 2. At the request of Netel, the Company will disconnect a Netel end user customer.
- 3. All requests by Netel for denial or disconnection of an end user for nonpayment must be in writing.
- 4. Netel will be made solely responsible for notifying the end user of the proposed disconnection of the service.
- 5. The Company will continue to process calls made to the Annoyance Call Center and will advise Netel when it is determined that annoyance calls are originated from one of their end user's locations. The Company shall be indemnified, defended and held harmless by Netel and/or the end user against any claim, loss or damage arising from providing this information to Netel. It is the responsibility of Netel to take the corrective action necessary with its customers who make annoying calls. Failure to do so will result in the Company's disconnecting the end user's service.
- B. The procedures for discontinuing service to Netsl are as follows:
  - The Company reserves the right to suspend or terminate service for nonpayment or in the event of prohibited, unlawful or improper use of the facilities or service, abuse of the facilities, or any other violation or noncompliance by Netel of the rules and regulations of the Company's Tariffs.
  - 2. If payment of account is not received by the bill day in the month after the original bill day, the Company may provide written notice to Netel, that additional applications for service will be refused and that any pending orders for service will not be completed if payment is not received by the fifteenth day following the date of the notice. If the Company does not refuse additional applications for service on the date specified in the notice, and Netel's noncompliance continues, nothing contained herein shall preclude the Company's right to refuse additional applications for service without further notice.
  - If payment of account is not received, or arrangements made, by the bill day in the second
    consecutive month, the account will be considered in default and will be subject to denial or
    disconnection, or both.
  - 4. If Netel falls to comply with the provisions of this Agreement, including any payments to be made by it on the dates and times herein specified, the Company may, on thirty days written notice to the person designated by Netel to receive notices of noncompliance, discontinue the provision of existing services to Netel at any time thereafter.
