BY THE COMMISSION:


By Order No. PSC-99-1064-PAA-TI issued on May 25, 1999, we granted interexchange telecommunications carrier Certificate No. 7011 to OPEX Communications, Inc. However, we inadvertently omitted the explanation that OPEX Communications, Inc. initially filed its request in the name of PremierCom, Inc. d/b/a/ PCI Telecommunications, Inc. Because another company had a similar sounding name, we were concerned that customer confusion would occur. However, PremierCom took steps after it filed its application to change its name to OPEX Communications. OPEX Communications is the name we approved for the certificate that was issued.

Therefore, Order No. PSC-99-1064-PAA-TI is amended to include this omitted information and reaffirmed in all other respects.

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Order No. PSC-99-1064-PAA-TI is hereby amended to include the omitted information as set forth in the body of this Order. It is further

ORDERED that Order No. PSC-99-1064-PAA-TI is reaffirmed in all other respects.
