ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION

By Petition, AT&T Communications of the Southern States, Inc. (AT&T or the company), has requested permission to intervene in this docket, which was established to investigate the pricing of unbundled network elements. AT&T is an alternative local exchange carrier (ALEC) and an interexchange company certified by this Commission to provide services in the State of Florida. AT&T alleges that, as an ALEC, it "purchases unbundled network elements from incumbent local exchange companies in order to provide local exchange service. Accordingly, AT&T's substantial interest may or will be affected by any action that the Commission takes in this docket regarding the pricing of network elements."

There has been no response filed in opposition to this request.

Having reviewed the Petition, it appears that the company's substantial interests may be affected by this proceeding. Therefore, the Petition should be granted. Pursuant to Rule 25.039, Florida Administrative Code, however, the company takes the case as it finds it.

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that the Petition for Leave to Intervene filed by AT&T Communications of the Southern States, Inc., be and the same is hereby granted. It is further

ORDERED that all parties to this proceeding shall furnish copies of all testimony, exhibits, pleadings and other documents which may hereinafter be filed in this proceeding, to:



NOTICE OF FURTHER PROCEEDINGS OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

The Florida Public Service Commission is required by Section 120.569(1), Florida Statutes, to notify parties of any administrative hearing or judicial review of Commission orders that is available under Sections 120.57 or 120.68, Florida Statutes, as well as the procedures and time limits that apply. This notice should not be construed to mean all requests for an administrative hearing or judicial review will be granted or result in the relief sought.

Mediation may be available on a case-by-case basis. If mediation is conducted, it does not affect a substantially interested person's right to a hearing.

Any party adversely affected by this order, which is preliminary, procedural or intermediate in nature, may request: (1) reconsideration within 10 days pursuant to Rule 25-22.0376, Florida Administrative Code, if issued by a Prehearing Officer; (2) reconsideration within 15 days pursuant to Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code, if issued by the Commission; or (3) judicial review by the Florida Supreme Court, in the case of an electric, gas or telephone utility, or the First District Court of Appeal, in the case of a water or wastewater utility. A motion for reconsideration shall be filed with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting, in the form prescribed by Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code. Judicial review of a preliminary, procedural or intermediate ruling or order is available if review
