NOTICE OF PROPOSED AGENCY ACTION ORDER APPROVING ASSIGNMENT OF AND NAME CHANGE ON ALTERNATIVE ACCESS VENDOR CERTIFICATE

BY THE COMMISSION:

NOTICE is hereby given by the Florida Public Service Commission that the action discussed herein is preliminary in nature and will become final unless a person whose interests are substantially affected files a petition for a formal proceeding, pursuant to Rule 25-22.029, Florida Administrative Code.

On May 19, 1999, Teligent, Inc. (Teligent) and Teligent Services, Inc. (Teligent Services) filed with this Commission a joint request for assignment of and name change on Alternative Access Vendor (AAV) Certificate No. 4707 from Teligent to Teligent Services.

Teligent and Teligent Services have complied with Rule 25-24.730, Florida Administrative Code, regarding the assignment of AAV certificates. We find the assignment to be in the public interest and, therefore, approve the assignment. AAV Certificate No. 4707 shall be amended to reflect that Teligent Services is the holder of this certificate.

If this Order becomes final and effective, it shall serve as Teligent Services' certificate. It should, therefore, be retained

by Teligent Services as proof of certification and as evidence of the name change.

AAVs are subject to Chapter 25-24, Florida Administrative Code, Part XV, Rules Governing Telecommunications Service Provided by Alternative Local Exchange Companies. AAVs are also required to comply with all applicable provisions of Chapter 364, Florida Statutes, and Chapters 25-4, Florida Administrative Code. AAV services providers are subject to Chapter 25-24, Florida Administrative Code, Part XIV, Rules Governing Alternative Access Vendor Services, as well as the terms and conditions of Order No. 24877, issued August 2, 1991.

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that the request for assignment of and name change on Alternative Access Vendor Certificate No. 4707 from Teligent, Inc. to Teligent Services, Inc., is hereby approved. It is further

ORDERED that Teligent Services, Inc.'s Alternative Access Vendor Certificate No. 4707 is subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the body of this Order. It is further

ORDERED that Alternative Access Vendor Certificate No. 4707 shall be amended to reflect that Teligent Services, Inc., is the holder of this certificate. It is further

ORDERED that this Order will serve as Teligent Services, Inc.'s certificate and that this Order should be retained as proof of certification and as evidence of the name change. It is further

ORDERED that Teligent Services, Inc. shall provide at least the same level of 911 services as that provided by the incumbent local exchange company serving the same area. It is further

ORDERED that the provisions of this Order, issued as proposed agency action, shall become final and effective upon the issuance of a Consummating Order unless an appropriate petition, in the form provided by Rule 28-106.201, Florida Administrative Code, is received by the Director, Division of Records and Reporting, 2540 Shumard Oak Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0850, by the close of business on the date set forth in the "Notice of Further Proceedings or Judicial Review" attached hereto. It is further
