ORDER APPROVING INTERCONNECTION, UNBUNDLING,
RESALE, AND COLLOCATION AGREEMENT

BY THE COMMISSION:

On October 19, 1999, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (BellSouth) and World Access Communication Corp. (World Access) filed a request for approval of an interconnection, unbundling resale, and collocation agreement pursuant to 47 U.S.C. §252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act). The agreement is incorporated by reference herein. A copy of the agreement may be obtained from the official docket file by contacting our Division of Records and Reporting.

Both the Act and Chapter 364, Florida Statutes, encourage parties to enter into negotiated agreements to bring about local exchange competition as quickly as possible. Under the requirements of 47 U.S.C. § 252(e), negotiated agreements must be submitted to the state commission for approval. Section 252(e)(4) requires the state to reject or approve the agreement within 90 days after submission or it shall be deemed approved.

This agreement covers a two-year period and governs the relationship between the companies regarding local interconnection and the exchange of traffic and physical collocation services

pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 251. The agreement states that collocation space will be provided for World Access in BellSouth's Central Office. Under 47 U.S.C. § 252(a)(1), the agreement shall include a detailed schedule of itemized charges for interconnection and each service or network element included in the agreement.

Upon review of the proposed agreement, we believe that it complies with the Act; thus, we hereby approve it. The Commission's approval of this agreement should not be construed as a determination that BellSouth has met the requirements of Section 271 of the Act. BellSouth and World Access are also required to file any subsequent supplements or modifications to their agreement with the Commission for review under the provisions of 47 U.S.C. § 252(e).


Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that the interconnection, unbundling resale, and collocation agreement between BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. and World Access Communication Corp., is incorporated by reference in this Order, and is hereby approved. A copy of the agreement may be obtained as specified in the body of this Order. It is further

ORDERED that any supplements or modifications to this agreement must be filed with the Commission for review under the provisions of 47 U.S.C. § 252(e). It is further

ORDERED that this docket shall be closed.
