ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION

By Petition, Intermedia Communications, Inc. (Intermedia) has requested permission to intervene in this proceeding. Intermedia states that it is certificated by the Florida Public Service Commission to provide both local and long distance telecommunications services in the State of Florida. Intermedia states that its ability to interconnect with incumbent local exchange companies (ILEC) for the provisioning of local telecommunications services on a nondiscriminatory basis depends on the utility of operations support systems performance metrics. Thus, Intermedia states that any decision in this case will substantially affect Intermedia's interests.

Having reviewed the Petition, it appears that Intermedia's substantial interests may be affected by this proceeding. As an ALEC operating in Florida, Intermedia states that it must utilize the operations support systems of ILECs to provide local exchange service. Thus, Intermedia has sufficiently demonstrated that its substantial interests may be affected by the outcome of this proceeding. Pursuant to Rule 25-22.039, Florida Administrative Code, Intermedia takes the case as it finds it.

Therefore, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that the Petition for Leave to Intervene filed by Intermedia Communications, Inc. is hereby granted. It is Further

ORDERED that all parties to this proceeding shall furnish copies of all testimony, exhibits, pleadings and other documents which may hereinafter be filed in this proceeding, to:



NOTICE OF FURTHER PROCEEDINGS OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

The Florida Public Service Commission is required by Section 120.569(1), Florida Statutes, to notify parties of any administrative hearing or judicial review of Commission orders that is available under Sections 120.57 or 120.68, Florida Statutes, as well as the procedures and time limits that apply. This notice should not be construed to mean all requests for an administrative hearing or judicial review will be granted or result in the relief sought.

Mediation may be available on a case-by-case basis. If mediation is conducted, it does not affect a substantially interested person's right to a hearing.

Any party adversely affected by this order, which is preliminary, procedural or intermediate in nature, may request: (1)

reconsideration within 10 days pursuant to Rule 25-22.0376, Florida Administrative Code, if issued by a Prehearing Officer; (2) reconsideration within 15 days pursuant to Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code, if issued by the Commission; or (3) judicial review by the Florida Supreme Court, in the case of an electric, gas or telephone utility, or the First District Court of Appeal, in the case of a water or wastewater utility. A motion for reconsideration shall be filed with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting, in the form prescribed by Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code. Judicial review of a preliminary, procedural or intermediate ruling or order is available if review of the final action will not provide an adequate remedy. Such review may be requested from the appropriate court, as described above, pursuant to Rule 9.100, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.
