ORDER VACATING ORDER NO. PSC-00-0437-PAA-TP

BY THE COMMISSION:

On January 21, 2000, International Exchange Communications, Inc. d/b/a IE COM (IE COM) and NOSVA Limited Partnership (NOSVA) filed with this Commission a joint application for request for approval of an asset purchase agreement whereby IE COM, holder of IXC Certificate No. 5798, would purchase and NOSVA, holder of IXC Certificate No. 3560, would sell the international operating division of NOSVA, including all customers thereof. By Order No. PSC-00-437-PAA-TP, issued March 2, 2000, and consummated by order No. PSC 00-0599-CO-TP we approved the transfer.

On August 28, 2000, the companies informed the Commission that the transaction did not take place. Since the transfer of control did not take place, we find it appropriate to vacate Order No. PSC-00-0437-PAA-TP.

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Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Order No. PSC-00-0421-PAA-TP is hereby vacated. It is further

ORDERED that this docket is closed.

NOTICE OF FURTHER PROCEEDINGS OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

The Florida Public Service Commission is required by Section 120.569(1), Florida Statutes, to notify parties of any administrative hearing or judicial review of Commission orders that is available under Sections 120.57 or 120.68, Florida Statutes, as well as the procedures and time limits that apply. This notice should not be construed to mean all requests for an administrative hearing or judicial review will be granted or result in the relief sought.

Any party adversely affected by the Commission's final action in this matter may request: 1) reconsideration of the decision by filing a motion for reconsideration with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting, 2540 Shumard Oak Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0850, within fifteen (15) days of the issuance of this order in the form prescribed by Rule 25-22.060, Florida

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Administrative Code; or 2) judicial review by the Florida Supreme Court in the case of an electric, gas or telephone utility or the First District Court of Appeal in the case of a water and/or wastewater utility by filing a notice of appeal with the Director, Division of Records and reporting and filing a copy of the notice of appeal and the filing fee with the appropriate court. This filing must be completed within thirty (30) days after the issuance of this order, pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure. The notice of appeal must be in the form specified in Rule 9.900(a), Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.
