NOTICE OF PROPOSED AGENCY ACTION  
ORDER APPROVING INDIRECT CHANGE OF CONTROL

BY THE COMMISSION:

NOTICE is hereby given by the Florida Public Service Commission that the action discussed herein is preliminary in nature and will become final unless a person whose interests are substantially affected files a petition for a formal proceeding, pursuant to Rule 25-22.029, Florida Administrative Code.

Section 364.33, Florida Statutes, provides that a person may not acquire ownership or control of any telecommunications facility, or any extension thereof for the purpose of providing telecommunications services to the public, including the acquisition, transfer, or assignment of majority organizational

control or controlling stock ownership, without prior approval from this Commission.

By letter dated January 16, 2001, Americatel Corporation d/b/a 10 123 Americatel d/b/a 1010 123 Americatel (Americatel) filed with this Commission an application for approval of indirect change in control of its majority shareholder, Entel International, B.V.I., a wholly owned subsidiary of Entel Chile S.A. Stet International Netherlands N.V. (Stet) is currently a minority shareholder of Entel Chile S.A. Stet plans to acquire shares in Entel Chile S.A. to become the majority shareholder. Entel International, B.V.I. will continue to have majority organizational control of Americatel.

Americatel is the holder of Interexchange Telecommunications Certificate No. 5313. Americatel has stated that the transaction will be virtually transparent to its customers in Florida and it will not affect the services being provided. Americatel has further stated that it will continue to operate under its existing certificated name and tariff on file with this Commission.

In accordance with our authority under Section 364.33, Florida Statutes, to approve the acquisition or transfer of majority organizational control or controlling stock ownership of a telecommunications company providing service in Florida, we have reviewed the Petition of Americatel and find it appropriate to approve it.

Based on the foregoing, it is,

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Americatel Corporation d/b/a 10 123 Americatel d/b/a 1010 123 Americatel's request for approval of indirect change in control of its majority shareholder, Entel International, B.V.I., a wholly owned subsidiary of Entel Chile S.A., is hereby approved. It is further


