NOTICE OF PROPOSED AGENCY ACTION
ORDER CANCELLING ALTERNATIVE LOCAL EXCHANGE
TELECOMMUNICATIONS CERTIFICATE AND INTEREXCHANGE
TELECOMMUNICATIONS CERTIFICATE

BY THE COMMISSION:

NOTICE is hereby given by the Florida Public Service Commission that the action discussed herein is preliminary in nature and will become final unless a person whose interests are substantially affected files a petition for a formal proceeding, pursuant to Rule 25-22.029, Florida Administrative Code.

(Omnicall), holder of Alternative Local Omnicall, Inc. Exchange Telecommunications (ALEC) Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 5293 and Interexchange Telecommunications (IXC) Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 5312, has requested the cancellation of Certificates Nos. 5293 and 5312 . Omnicall has complied with the provision of Rule 25-24.820(2), Florida Administrative Code, by providing adequate notice in writing of its request for cancellation of its. ALEC certificate and by submitting its Regulatory Assessment Fees

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(RAFs) for the year 2000. Accordingly, we find it appropriate to cancel ALEC Certificate No. 5293 and IXC Certificate No. 5312, effective June 14, 2001.

In addition, under Section 364.336, Florida Statutes, certificate holders must pay a minimum annual RAFs of \$50 if the certificate was active during any portion of the calendar year. A RAFs Return notice for the year 2001 will be mailed to Omnicall. Neither the cancellation of its certificate nor the failure to receive a RAFs Return notice for the year 2001 shall relieve Omnicall from its obligation to pay RAFs for the year 2001.

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Omnicall, Inc.'s Certificates Nos. 5293 and 5312 to provide Alternative Local Exchange Telecommunications and Interexchange Telecommunications services are hereby canceled, effective June 14, 2001. It is further

ORDERED that Omnicall, Inc. shall remit Regulatory Assessment Fees for the year 2001. It is further

ORDERED that the provisions of this Order, issued as proposed agency action, shall become final and effective upon the issuance of a Consummating Order unless an appropriate petition, in the form provided by Rule 28-106.201, Florida Administrative Code, is received by the Director, Division of the Commission Clerk and Administrative Services, 2540 Shumard Oak Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0850, by the close of business on the date set forth in the "Notice of Further Proceedings or Judicial Review" attached hereto. It is further

ORDERED that in the event this Order becomes final, this Docket shall be closed.
