BY THE COMMISSION:

By letter dated September 12, 2001, Bluewater Communications Corporation, holder of Alternative Local Exchange Telecommunications (ALEC) Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 7864 and Interexchange Telecommunications (IXC) Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 7865, requested that Certificate No. 7864 and Certificate No. 7865 be amended to reflect the new corporate name, North American Telecommunications Corporation. Upon review of the Department of State, Division of Corporations' records, it appears that Bluewater Communications Corporation has properly registered the new corporate name. Accordingly, we find it appropriate to amend Certificate No. 7864 and Certificate No. 7865 to reflect the new corporate name.

This Order will serve as the amended ALEC Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 7864 and IXC Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 7865 for North American Telecommunications Corporation. North American Telecommunications Corporation should retain this Order as evidence of the name change. The Commission is vested with jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Section 364.335, Florida Statutes.

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that the request by Bluewater Communications Corporation to change the name on Certificate No. 7864 and Certificate No. 7865 from Bluewater


Communications Corporation to North American Telecommunications Corporation is hereby approved. It is further

Any party adversely affected by the Commission's final action in this matter may request: 1) reconsideration of the decision by filing a motion for reconsideration with the Director, Division of the Commission Clerk and Administrative Services, 2540 Shumard Oak Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0850, within fifteen (15) days of the issuance of this order in the form prescribed by Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code; or 2) judicial review by the Florida Supreme Court in the case of an electric, gas or telephone utility or the First District Court of Appeal in the case of a water and/or wastewater utility by filing a notice of appeal with the Director, Division of the Commission Clerk and Administrative Services and filing a copy of the notice of appeal and the filing fee with the appropriate court. This filing must be completed within thirty (30) days after the issuance of this order, pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure. The notice of appeal must be in the form specified in Rule 9.900(a), Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.
