ORDER ACKNOWLEDGING NAME CHANGE

BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 4, 2002, we received documentation from WAMnet Communications Inc., holder of Alternative Local Exchange Telecommunications (ALEC) Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 7162, requesting that Certificate No. 7162 be amended to reflect the new corporate name, Airface Communications Inc. Upon review of the Department of State, Division of Corporations' records, it appears that WAMnet Communications Inc. has properly registered the new corporate name. Accordingly, we find it appropriate to amend Certificate No. 7162 to reflect the new corporate name.

This Order will serve as the amended ALEC Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 7162 for Airface Communications Inc. Airface Communications Inc. should retain this Order as evidence of the name change. We are vested with jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Section 364.335, Florida Statutes.

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that the request by WAMnet Communications Inc. to change the name on Certificate No. 7162 from WAMnet Communications Inc. to Airface Communications Inc. is hereby approved. It is further

ORDERED that this Order will serve as Airface Communications Inc.'s amended certificate and that this Order should be retained as evidence of the name change. It is further

ORDERED that this change will be effective upon issuance of this Order. It is further

Any party adversely affected by the Commission's final action in this matter may request: 1) reconsideration of the decision by

filing a motion for reconsideration with the Director, Division of the Commission Clerk and Administrative Services, 2540 Shumard Oak Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0850, within fifteen (15) days of the issuance of this order in the form prescribed by Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code; or 2) judicial review by the Florida Supreme Court in the case of an electric, gas or telephone utility or the First District Court of Appeal in the case of a water and/or wastewater utility by filing a notice of appeal with the Director, Division of the Commission Clerk and Administrative Services and filing a copy of the notice of appeal and the filing fee with the appropriate court. This filing must be completed within thirty (30) days after the issuance of this order, pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure. The notice of appeal must be in the form specified in Rule 9.900(a), Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.
