## NOTICE OF PROPOSED AGENCY ACTION ORDER CANCELLING ALTERNATIVE LOCAL EXCHANGE TELECOMMUNICATIONS CERTIFICATE

BY THE COMMISSION:

NOTICE is hereby given by the Florida Public Service Commission that the action discussed herein is preliminary in nature and will become final unless a person whose interests are substantially affected files a petition for a formal proceeding, pursuant to Rule 25-22.029, Florida Administrative Code.

Eureka Telecom, L.C.C. (Eureka), holder of Alternative Local Exchange Telecommunications Certificate (ALEC) of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 7653, has requested the cancellation of ALEC Certificate No. 7653. Eureka has complied with the provision of Rule 25-24.820(2), Florida Administrative Code, by providing adequate notice in writing of its request for cancellation of its ALEC certificate and by submitting its Regulatory Assessment Fees (RAFs) for the years 2001 and 2002. Accordingly, we find it appropriate to cancel ALEC Certificate No.

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7653, effective October 30, 2002. We are vested with jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Section 364.335, Florida Statutes.

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Eureka Telecom, L.C.C.'s Certificate No. 7653 to provide Alternative Local Exchange Telecommunications services is hereby canceled, effective October 20, 2002. It is further

ORDERED that in the event this Order becomes final, this docket shall be closed.
