AMENDATORY ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On October 31, 2003, we issued Order No. PSC-03-1232-CO-TA. The purpose of the order was to cancel Commercial Communications Systems, Inc. Alternative Access Vendor (AAV) Certificate. However, due to a scrivener's error, the Consummating Order (CO) closed the docket even though the Proposed Agency Action (PAA) required it to remain open for 14 calendar days for the receipt of penalties, Regulatory Assessment Fees (RAFS) including statutory penalties and interest charges. Therefore, Order No. PSC-03-1232-CO-TA is amended to reflect the Docket will remain open 14 calendar days after the issuance of consummating order.

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Order No. PSC-03-1232-CO-TA is hereby amended to reflect the Docket will remain open for 14 calendar days after the issuance of consummating order for the receipt of penalties, RAFS including statutory penalties and interest charges. It is further

ORDERED that Order No. PSC-03-1232-CO-TA is reaffirmed in all other respects.


