FPL asserts that portions of staff's working papers contain information pertaining to internal auditing reports and associated documents. FPL further asserts that portions of staff's working papers contain information pertaining to FPL's fuel and purchased power transactions

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and the practices and procedures for such transactions. According to FPL, the disclosure of such information would inhibit FPL's ability to enter into power purchase transactions on favorable terms for the benefit of its customers in the future and would impair the competitive interests of FPL. FPL contends that certain information would place FPL at a disadvantage when coupled with other information that is publicly available.

FPL asserts that, pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, such information is entitled to confidential classification and is exempt from the mandatory disclosure provisions of the public records law. FPL asserts that the sensitive contractual and competitive information, if disclosed, would impair the efforts of the public utility or its affiliates to contract for goods or services on favorable terms. Section 366.093(3)(d), Florida Statutes. FPL also asserts that the information for which it seeks confidential classification relates "to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of the information." Section 366.093(3)(e), Florida Statutes.

CONCLUSION

Upon review, it appears that the information discussed above is proprietary confidential business information and should be granted confidential treatment to avoid harm to the company and its ratepayers. Based on the foregoing, FPL's request for confidential treatment of Document Nos. 06511-04 and 06981-04 is granted.

Pursuant to Section 366.093(4), Florida Statutes, the information for which confidential classification is granted herein shall remain protected from disclosure for a period of 18 months from the date of issuance of this order. At the conclusion of the 18 month period, the confidential information will no longer be exempt from Section 119.07(1), Florida Statutes, unless FPL or another affected person shows, and the Commission finds, that the records continue to contain proprietary confidential business information.

It is therefore

ORDERED by Commissioner Rudolph "Rudy" Bradley, as Prehearing Officer, that the information described in Florida Power and Light Company's request for confidential treatment of certain portions of staff's working papers, Audit No. 04-096-4-1, Document Nos. 06511-04 and 06981-04, is granted confidential classification. It is further

ORDERED that the information described within the body of this Order shall be granted confidential treatment for 18 months from the date of this Order. It is further

ORDERED that this Order will be the only notification by the Commission to the parties of the date of declassification of the materials discussed herein.

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NOTICE OF FURTHER PROCEEDINGS OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

The Florida Public Service Commission is required by Section 120.569(1), Florida Statutes, to notify parties of any administrative hearing or judicial review of Commission orders that is available under Sections 120.57 or 120.68, Florida Statutes, as well as the procedures and time limits that apply. This notice should not be construed to mean all requests for an administrative hearing or judicial review will be granted or result in the relief sought.

Mediation may be available on a case-by-case basis. If mediation is conducted, it does not affect a substantially interested person's right to a hearing.

Any party adversely affected by this order, which is preliminary, procedural or intermediate in nature, may request: (1) reconsideration within 10 days pursuant to Rule 25-22.0376, Florida Administrative Code; or (2) judicial review by the Florida Supreme Court, in the case of an electric, gas or telephone utility, or the First District Court of Appeal, in the case of a water or wastewater utility. A motion for reconsideration shall be filed with the Director, Division of the Commission Clerk and Administrative Services, in the form prescribed by Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code. Judicial review of a preliminary, procedural or intermediate ruling or order is available if review of the final action will not provide an adequate remedy. Such review may be requested from the appropriate court, as described above, pursuant to Rule 9.100, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.
