ORDER ACKNOWLEDGING NAME CHANGE FROM
NUI CITY GAS COMPANY OF FLORIDA, A DIVISION OF NUI UTILITIES INC.
TO FLORIDA CITY GAS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By letter dated December 7, 2004, NUI City Gas Company of Florida, a division of NUI Utilities, Inc. (City Gas) filed a request to change its name to Florida City Gas, effective December 6, 2004. Upon review of the records of the Department of State, Division of Corporations, it appears that the name, Florida City Gas is properly registered. Accordingly, we find it appropriate to acknowledge City Gas' name change to Florida City Gas. Florida City Gas shall use the name Florida City Gas on all future tariff filings as they arise in the normal course of business and shall complete revisions of all remaining tariffs to reflect the name change by January 7, 2005. In addition, Florida City Gas shall continue to provide goods and services as they were provided under the name of NUI City Gas Company of Florida, a division of NUI Utilities, Inc.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that the request of NUI City Gas Company of Florida, a division of NUI Utilities, Inc. to change its name to Florida City Gas is hereby acknowledged. It is further

ORDERED that Florida City Gas shall use the name Florida City Gas on all future tariff filings as they arise in the normal course of business and shall complete revisions of all remaining tariffs to reflect the name change by January 7, 2005. It is further

ORDERED that Florida City Gas shall continue to provide goods and services as they were provided under the name of NUI City Gas Company of Florida, a division of NUI Utilities, Inc. It is further

ORDERED that Florida City Gas shall continue to charge the rates and charges approved for NUI City Gas Company of Florida, a division of NUI Utilities Inc., until authorized to change by this Commission in a subsequent proceeding. It is further

ORDERED that this docket is hereby closed.

NOTICE OF FURTHER PROCEEDINGS OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

The Florida Public Service Commission is required by Section 120.569(1), Florida Statutes, to notify parties of any administrative hearing or judicial review of Commission orders that is available under Sections 120.57 or 120.68, Florida Statutes, as well as the procedures and time limits that apply. This notice should not be construed to mean all requests for an administrative hearing or judicial review will be granted or result in the relief sought.

Any party adversely affected by the Commission's final action in this matter may request: 1) reconsideration of the decision by filing a motion for reconsideration with the Director, Division of the Commission Clerk and Administrative Services, 2540 Shumard Oak Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0850, within fifteen (15) days of the issuance of this order in the form prescribed by Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code; or 2) judicial review by the Florida Supreme Court in the case of an electric, gas or telephone utility or the First District Court of Appeal in the case of a water and/or wastewater utility by filing a notice of appeal with the Director, Division of the Commission Clerk and Administrative Services and filing a copy of the notice of appeal and the filing fee with the appropriate court. This filing must be completed within thirty (30) days after the issuance of this order, pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure. The notice of appeal must be in the form specified in Rule 9.900(a), Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.
